RESOLUTION

Of the Legislature of the State of North Carolina in relation to the pay of disabled soldiers.

Resolved, That our senators and representatives in Congress be requested to use their influence in procuring the passage of a law which shall allow pay to soldiers discharged from the army on account of being disabled, such as is given to those who are placed on the retired list but not actually discharged.

Ratified the 22d day of December, A. D., 1864.
