Express Companies. **I will pay freight charges on all orders that amount to \$10.00, or more.**

In ordering by Express send one-fourth cash with order and then I will send the order C. O. D. In ordering always give size, age and price as per this list. My references are the Harbine Bank of Fairbury, and the First National Bank of Fairbury, Neb.

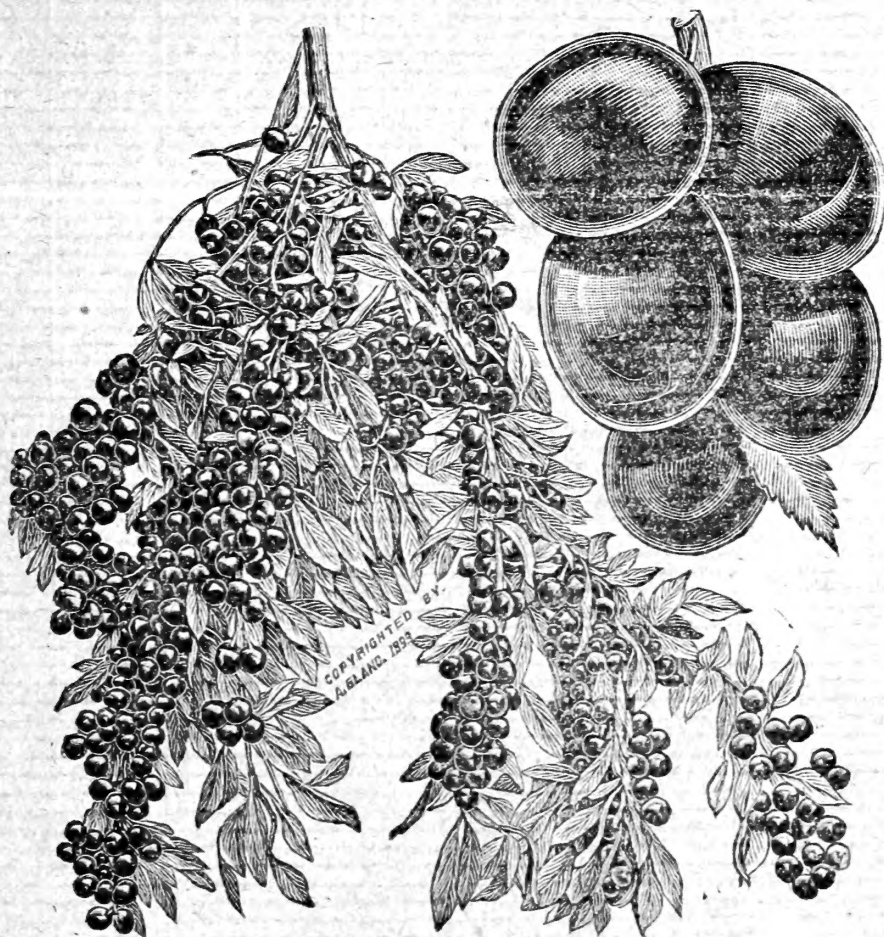

This is the most productive Cherry. The fruit is as large as the Morella, is black and in flavor akin to the sweet cherries. It is more of a bush than a tree and grows to the height of 4 to 5 feet. Perfectly hardy, as it is found wild in Canada.
