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

The Parson sneezes, and, in great fear for his precious life thinks he'd better go to Europe for the benefit of his health.






And his Family's (The Parson always has a large one)





He consults one of the pillars and tells him of his threatened malady-Pillar suggests Lake. Superior-Parson thinks he couldn't stand the climate.





He hastily gathers together some necessaries for his royage - (The above sketch shows a part of the baggage)






The Parson receives an offering from his flock to defray his travelling expenses. He is much touched by it and congratulates himself that "All the fools are not dead yet."






He commences his farewell Sermon






He describes his anguish at the thought of parting from the loved ones who so substantially have testified their devotion.

It is an old idea, but is regularly done.











Having had his hair cut in the French style, he sends it home in the above manner for his flock-




