Others find what they are looking for through relationships with others, or through different forms of recreation — such as games — sports — hobbies. For some the answer can be found in something as simple as beauty.









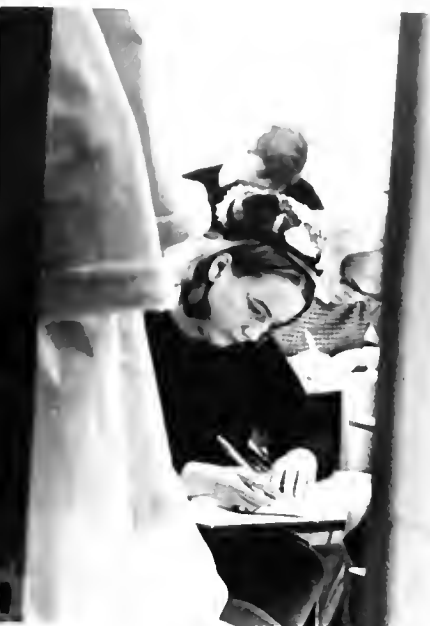

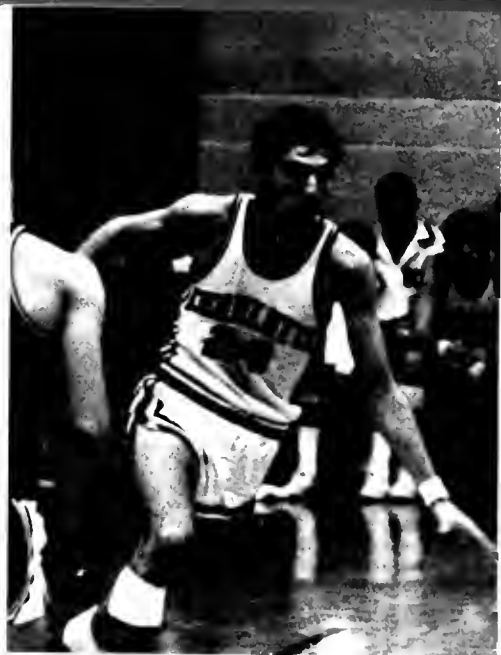






Ben Basinger

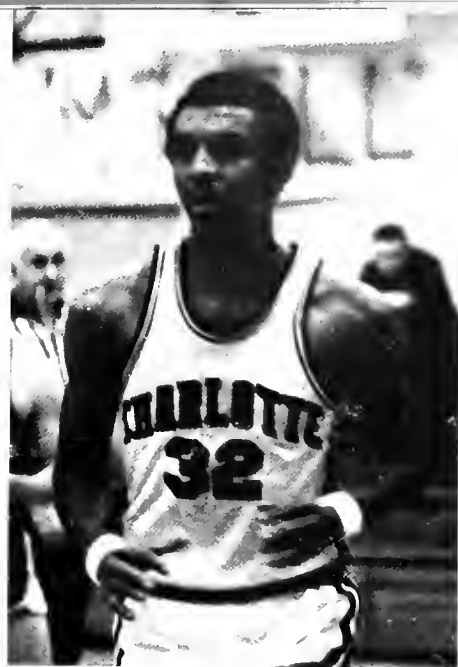

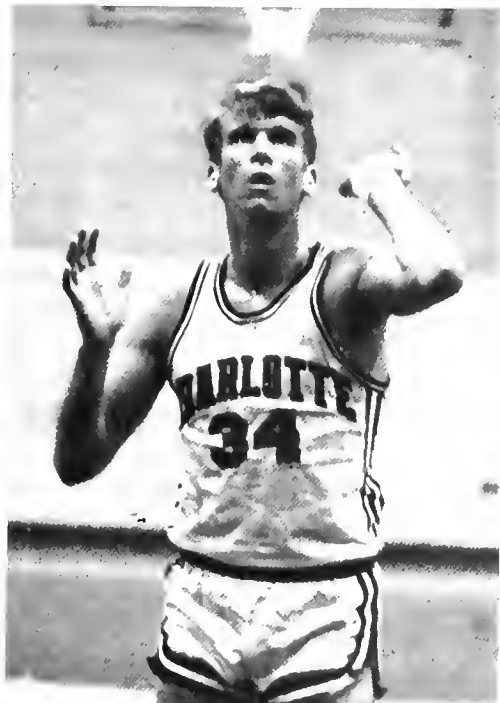

**COMMUNICATION:  
THE KEY TO UNDERSTANDING—**

March 3, 1969
