### 3.7 Main vowels ( $\mathrm{V}_{\mathrm{m}}$ )

17 contrastive vowel phonemes can occur in $\mathrm{V}_{\mathrm{m}}$ position, 11 of them in the long vowel set and 6 in the short vowel set. Long vowels can occur in either closed or open syllables, but short vowels occur only in closed syllables.
