

Segmental unit phonemes are *p t tj k; b d dj g; f s sj; v z zj; m n nj ng; l r; w j* (semivowels); *h; i u, e o*, lower-mid ϵ and ə , *a, ə*. *tj* and *dj* are palatal affricates; *sj* and *zj* are hushing sibilants; *nj* and *ng* are, respectively, palatal and velar nasals ([ŋg] is written *ngg*). The acute accent shows stress; the circumflex, a long, falling tone.
