Pater is an Austronesian language of the Buang language family in the Morobe Province of Papua New Guinea. It is part of the Mumeng dialect chain and is spoken by approximately 1,200 speakers. Most of these speakers live in five villages in proximity to the Lae-Wau road.

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The workpapers in this volume express the authors' knowledge at the time of writing. They do not necessarily provide a complete treatment of their topic. However, it is felt that these papers should be made available at this time.
