The Rade Tribe is one of the most influential tribes in the highlands of South Viet Nam. The population of the tribe is estimated at between 80,000 and 100,000. They are located throughout Darlac and part of Khanh Hoa provinces though centered around the city of Banmethuot. They are variously referred to as Raday, Rdê, Êdê, Rhade. Their principal subgroups are Mdhur, Adham, Blo, Kodrao, Bih, Krung, and Rdê Kpă.
