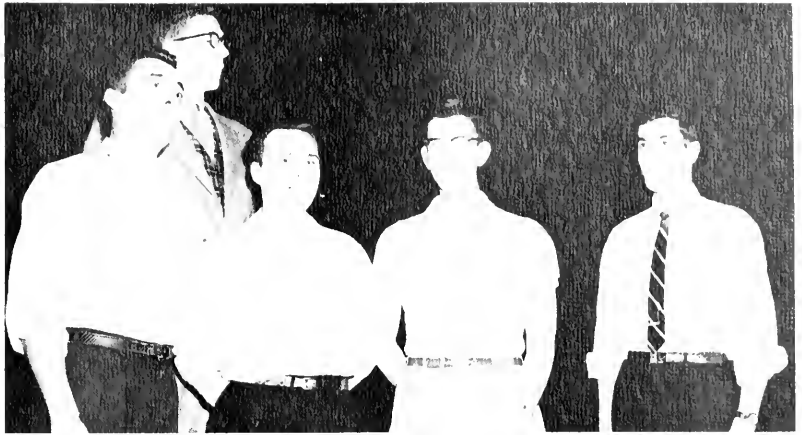

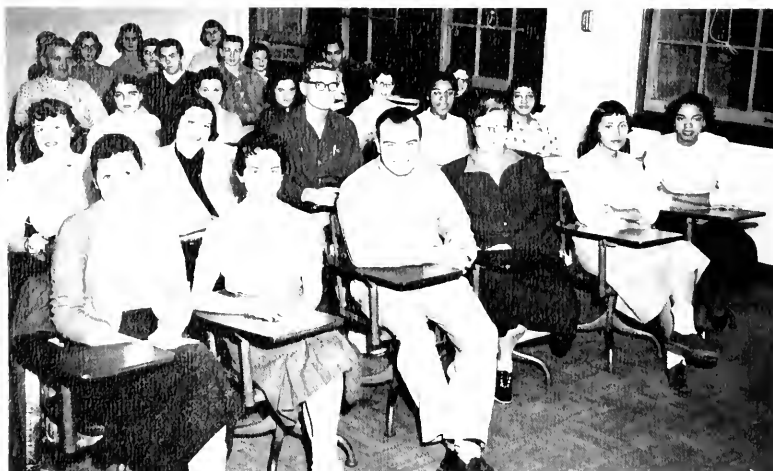

## All Star Shows

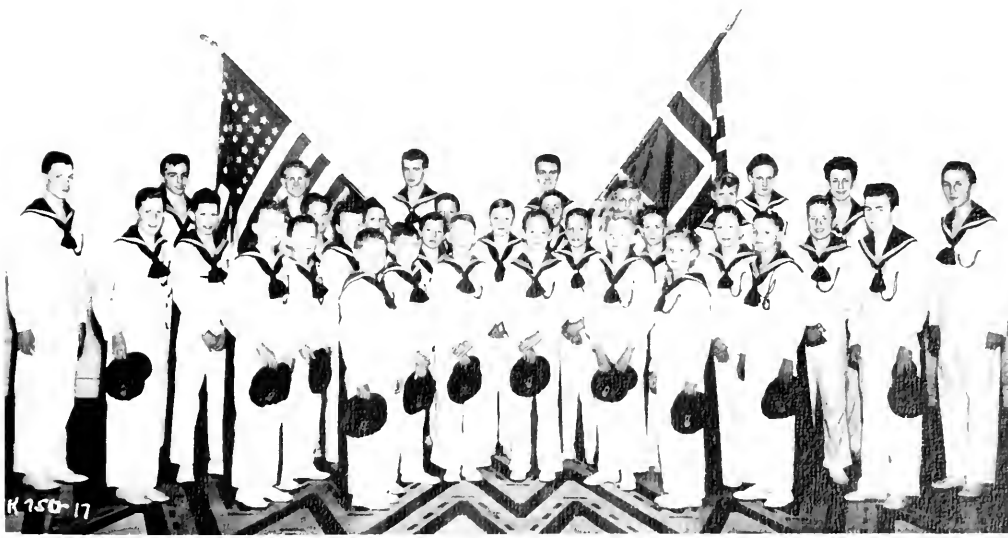

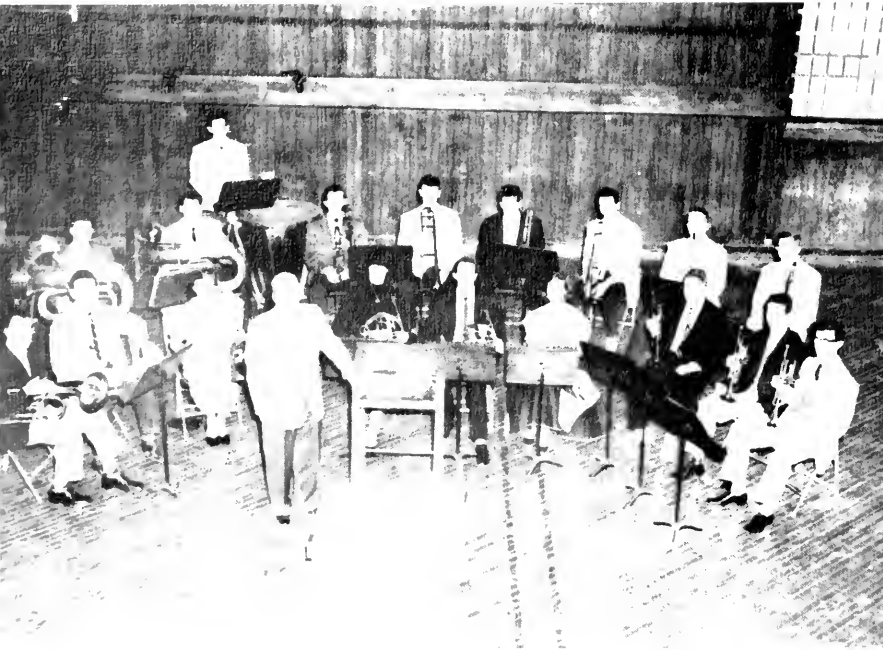

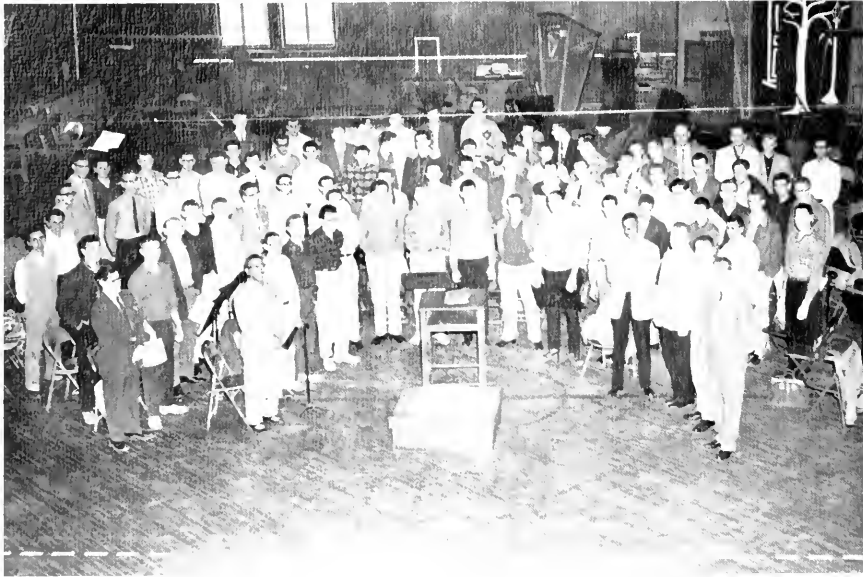

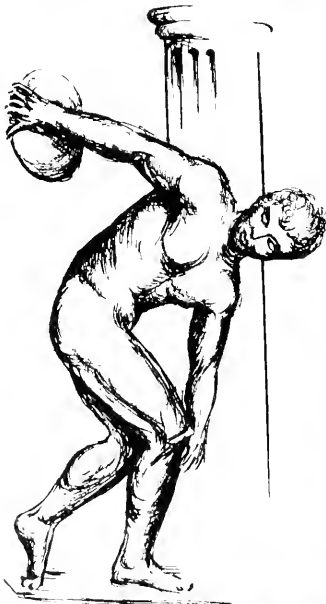

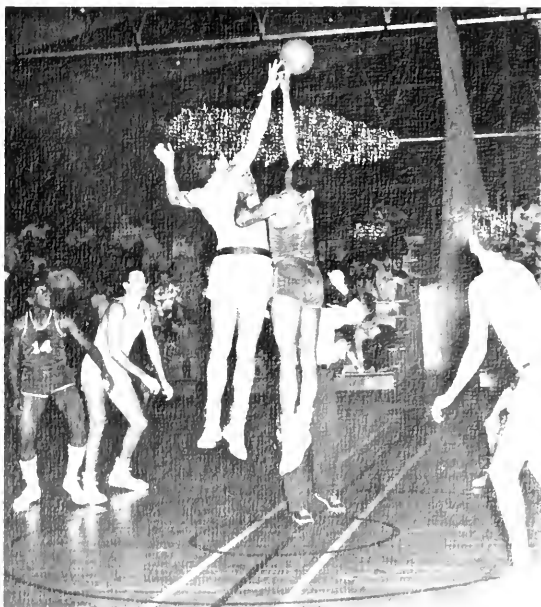

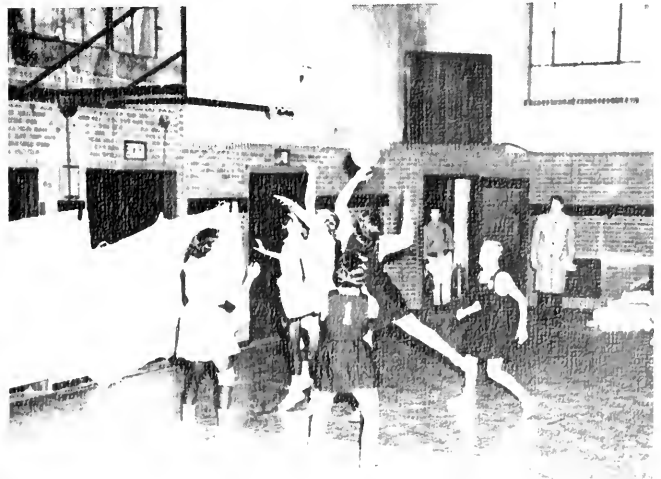

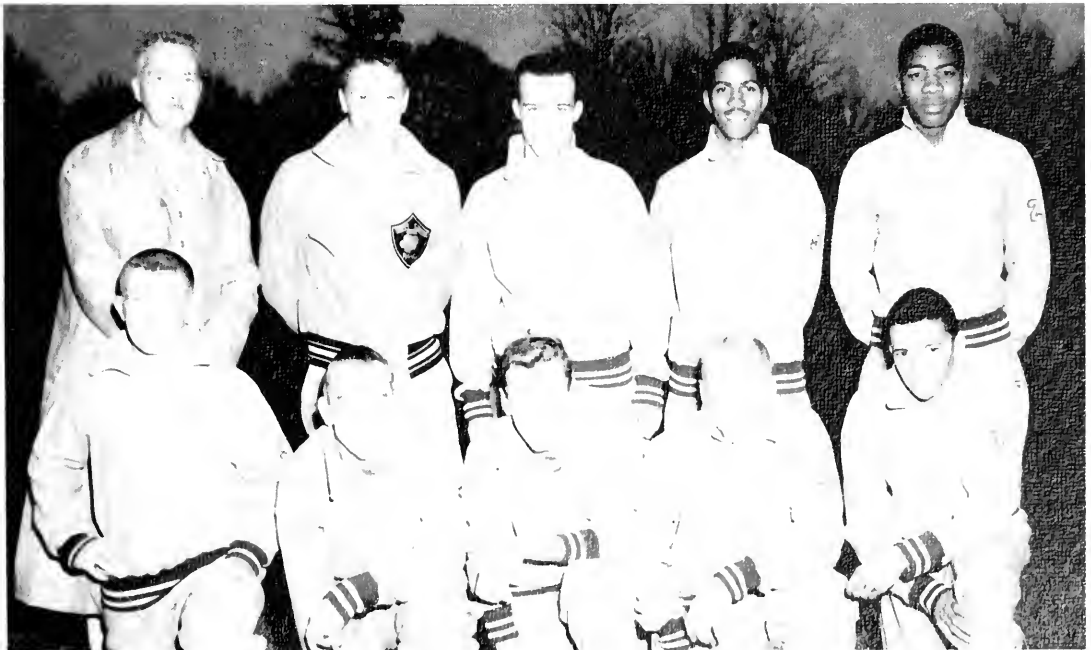

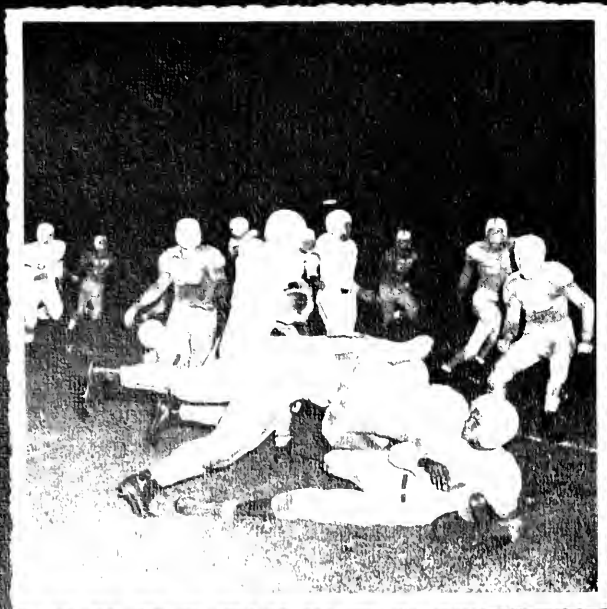

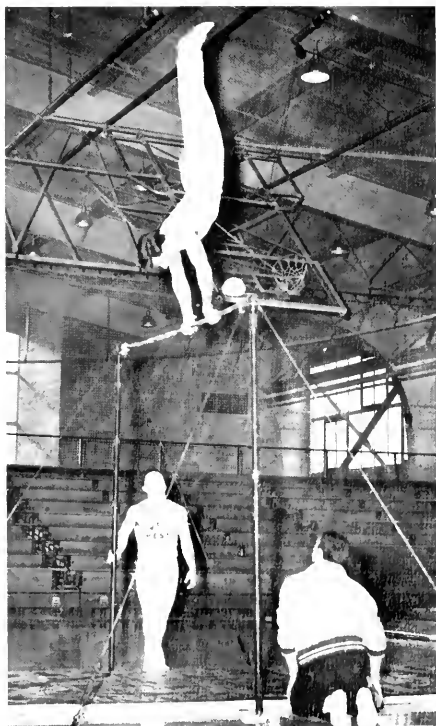

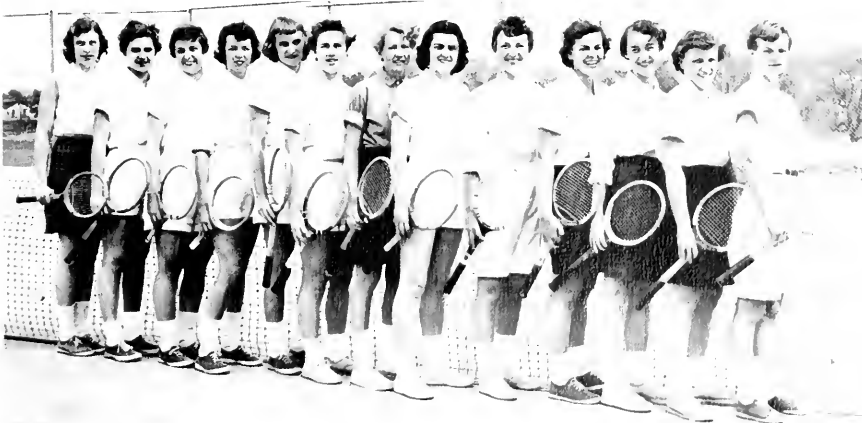

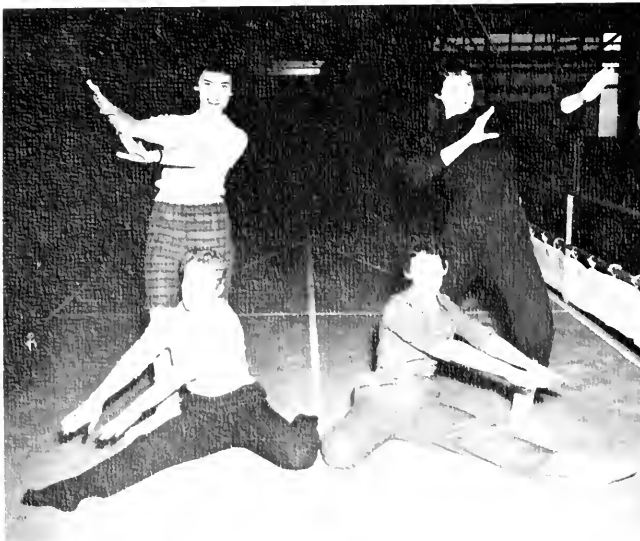
