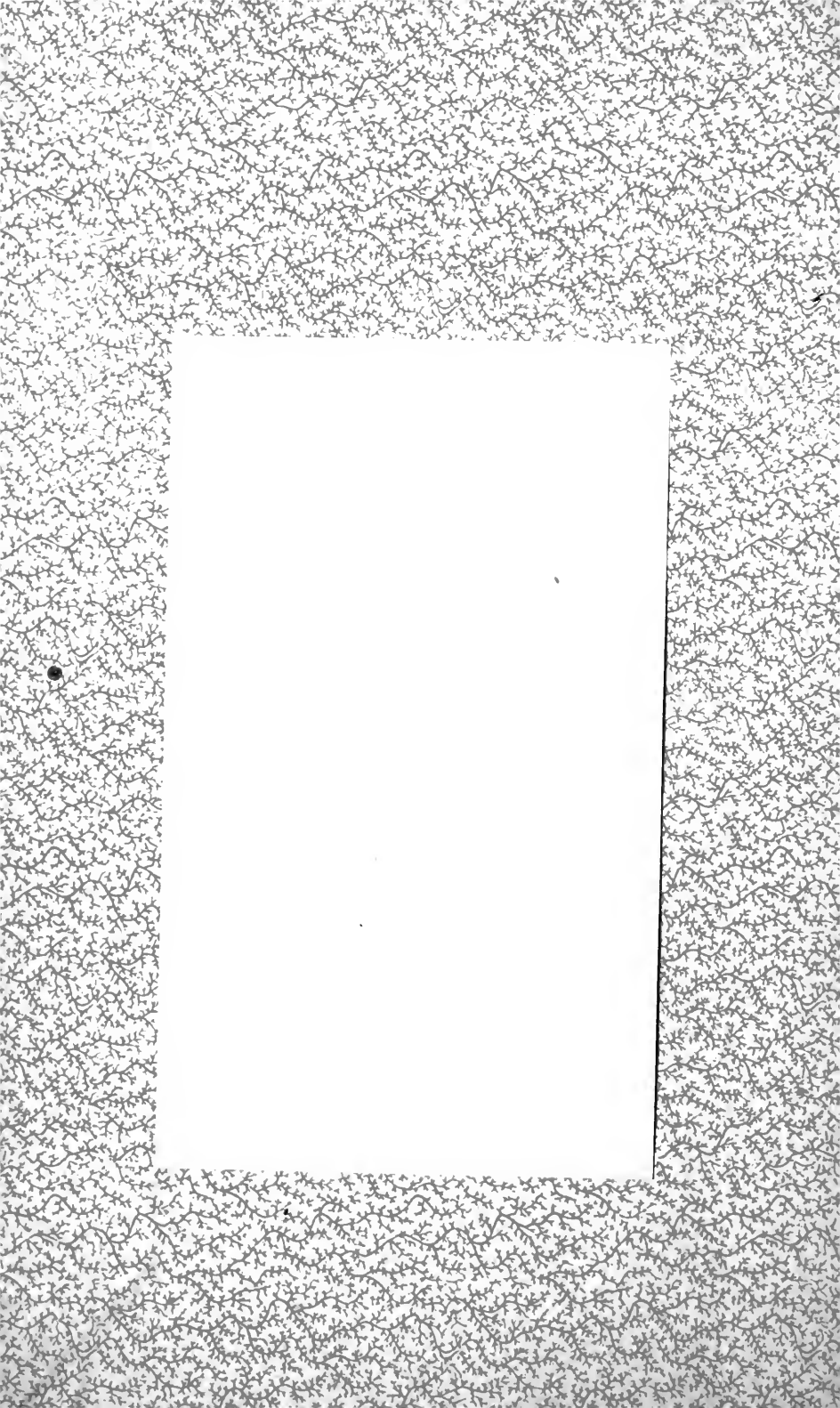
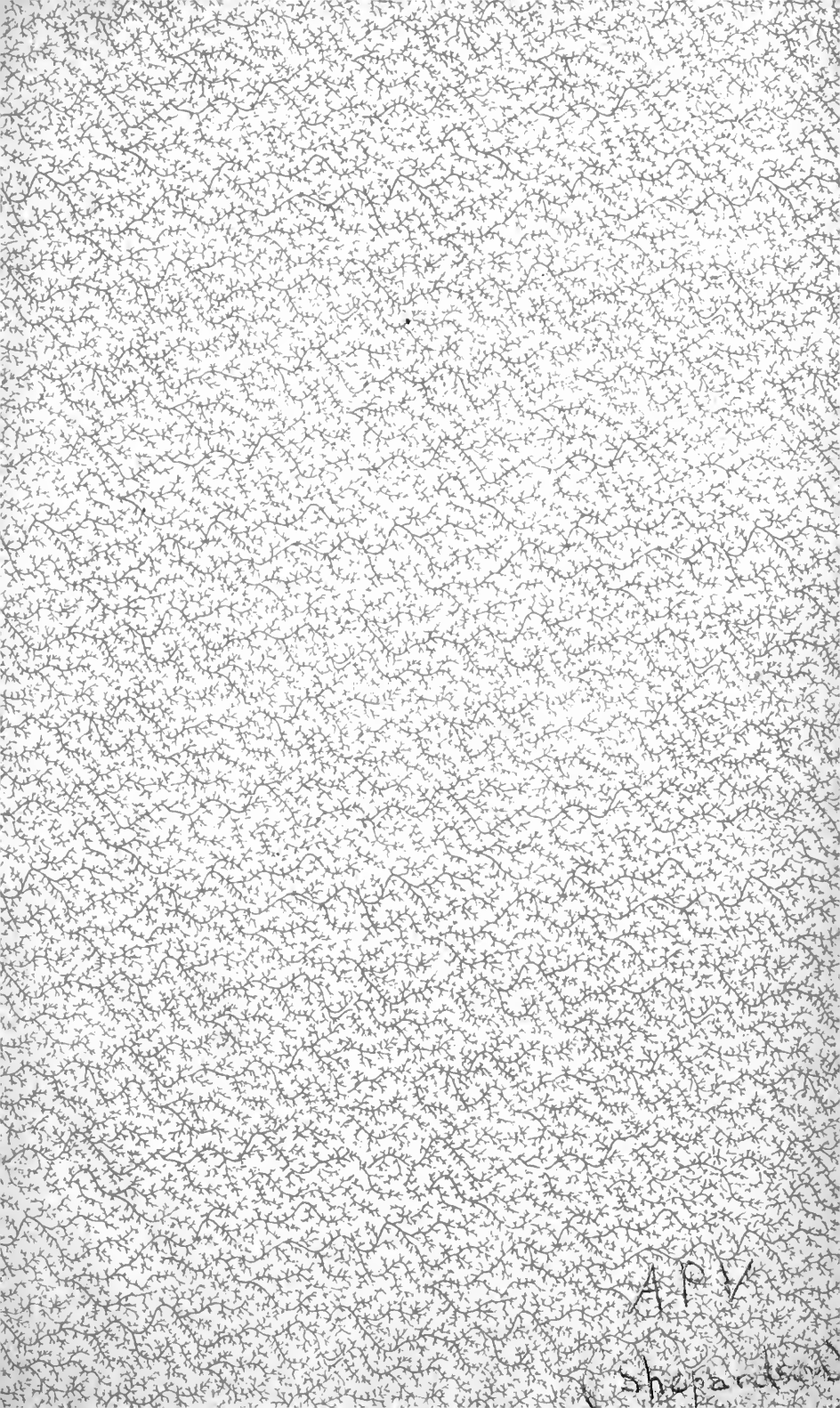


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# THE SHEPARDSON FAMILY.

Some Miscellaneous Records of Several Generations.

Manwaring: Early Connecticut Probate Records, p. 178.) The records of East Haddam previous to 29 May, 1832, are said to be in Colchester.
