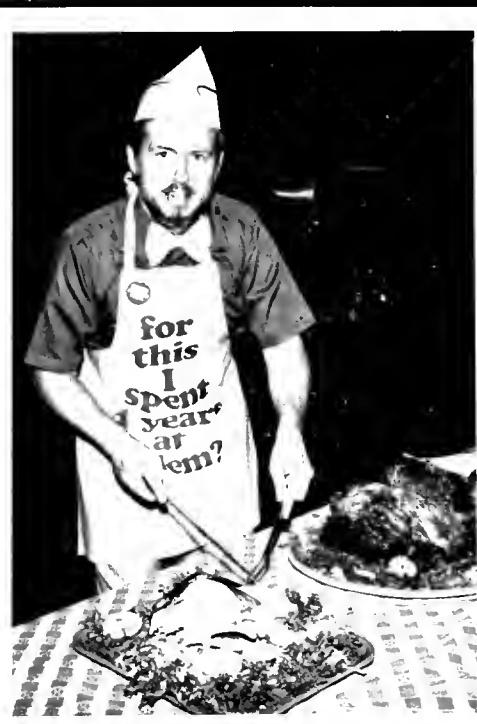

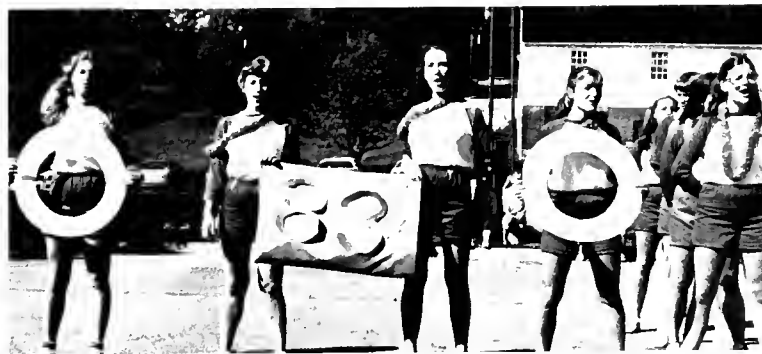
Salem On Stage

Friday, October 30th: Scavenger Hunt and Halloween Carnival.

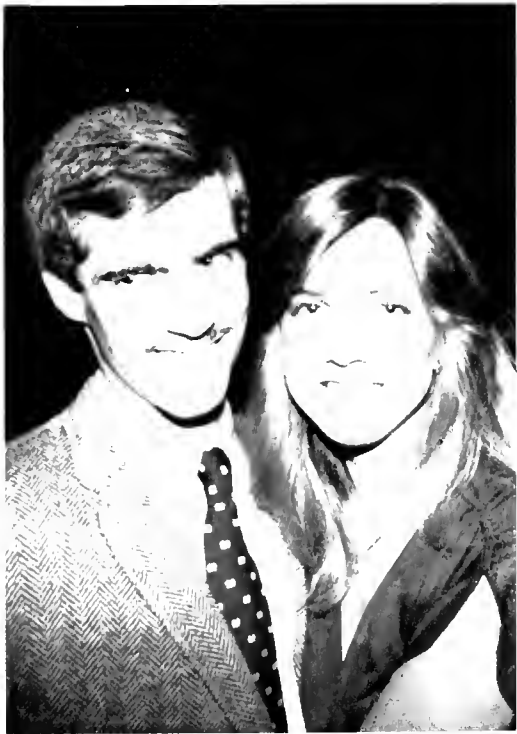
From devils to bees, everyone came dressed as their favorite halloween character to the tape show in the refectory.
