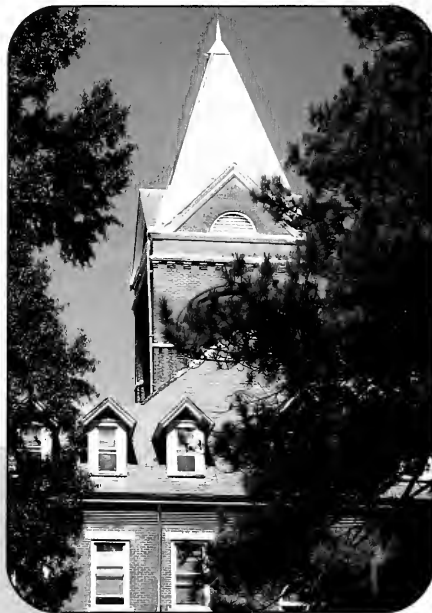

# Leadership Retreat

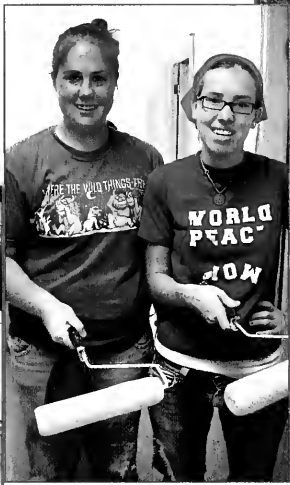
"You must be the change you wish to see in the world." -Gandhi

# Study Abroad



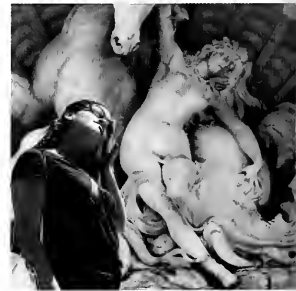

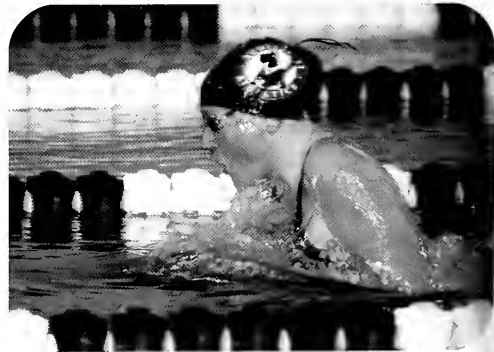

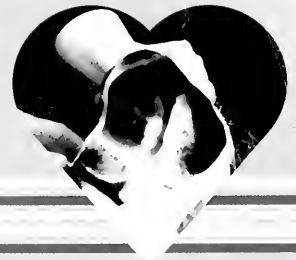
# Sophomore Family Weekend
