



EVERAL years ago the author of this work conceived the idea of collecting, for his own gratification, all the available information relating to the life of his grand-father, Alexander Alexander, together with the names, date of birth, date of marriage and to whom, and date of death of his children. Owing to the absence of many family records and the death of the "oldest inhabitant," a difficult task was undertaken, but, after considerable

research, many important facts and dates, unknown to many of the descendants, have been brought to light. While engaged upon this work, it was found that many family records have been lost, while others show the marks of age to such an extent that in a few years they will be illegible and ere long we will be ignorant of the names of our forefathers, so it was suggested that a Genealogical Record, in permanent form, of the descendants of Alexander Alexander, together with the residence of those living, would be a source of satisfaction to many of our kindred. With the Sketch of our common ancestor, a Chart and Genealogical Record have been added to the author's original purpose; the Chart shows at a glance three generations of our ancestors, with date of birth, date of marriage and to whom, date of death of those dead, and the residence of those living. The Genealogical Record in a like manner gives the names of the descendants down to the present, or to the time when the records were obtained, with the postoffice address of those living; where the address is omitted it is that of the parent or grand-parent, so, with this work before us, we can place ourselves in communication with any of the living descendants of Alexander Alexander, scattered as they are through seventeen different States, the District of Columbia, and one is even found in distant China. In the Genealogical Record, the fourth generation comes to within about an inch of the left side of the page, and each subsequent generation about one-fourth of an inch farther in, thus at a glance you can see to what generation you belong.

The entire work contains the names of Alexander Alexander's 7 children, 33 grand-children, 168 great-grand-children, 468 great-gr

of 1156, estimated at over 95 per cent. of all his descendants. The failure in not having the complete record lies with others, as over 1,000 letters of inquiry, each containing a stamp, or a stamped addressed envelope, were sent out to the numerous descendants, some of the letters still remaining unanswered. If the record is not complete, it is a great satisfaction to know that, in the main, it is correct, as the best evidence, the family records, has been used, in the absence of which other records and secondary evidence have been resorted to, but always with close scrutiny. Several blank pages have been added at the end of the work for a family record, or to afford those who may be so inclined an opportunity to continue the Genealogical Record from the point where the author ceased. The earliest dates in such records are always the most difficult to obtain, but, with these given, it will be little trouble to keep up the record in the future.

Among the numerous descendants are to be found those occupying prominent places in all the different professions, while the great majority are engaged in that independent and honorable calling, the tilling of the soil. The biographies of all the descendants are purposely omitted, as being beyond the scope of this work, although pages could be written of many of them; no partiality has been shown, all have been treated alike. All titles of office and honor have also been omitted, as it is enough to know that we have all descended from a good and honorable ancestry which should incite us and our posterity to act worthy of such a parentage.

HE name Alexander is of Grecian origin and signifies a "Helper of Men." The name was first used as a surname, but upon the introduction of the christian name it was adopted by many who appreciated the advantage of the advance in nomenclature. There is no doubt that it had been used for some time as a christian name in Scotland before the period of which history speaks, when we are informed that Alexander MacDonald, second son of Donal, King of the Isles, had two sons who adopted the christian name of their father as a surname for themselves and their descendants. Numerous clans of Alexanders descended from the ancient clan of the MacDonald, including both a nobility and a commonalty. The chiefs of these clans at first resided in the South of Scotland and were Earls of Sterling and Dovan.

In the period following the rebellion, by the defeat and outlawry of certain of the Irish chiefs under the reign of James I of England, who was also James VI of Scotland, vast estates were divided into small tracts and given to the Scotch Protestants on the condition that they should settle permanently in Ireland. King James had a dual object in view in this act, one to replace the Catholics by Protestants, the other to secure for himself loyal subjects in the place of rebels. A settlement of Scotch Presbyterians in the midst of the Celtic Catholics meant a perpetual and increasing garrison of friends of the home government in the midst of a hostile population, and which proved the wisdom of James I, when under the reign of William III, of Orange, they saved Ireland for the British Crown.

The distance from Scotland to Ireland at some points is less than twenty miles, and thousands of Scots, all men of enterprise, energy and above the average in intelligence, went over and took pos-

session of the confiscated lands, and among those who availed themselves of this opportunity were many of the Alexanders, who settled in Counties Antrim, Armagh and Down. These families included both the commonalty and nobility, many of whom long enjoyed and do still enjoy hereditary nobility and honorable positions both in church and state.

In after years, under Catholic governments, the descendants of the Scots in Ireland were bitterly persecuted, and early in the last century large numbers of them, including many of the yeomanry bearing the name of Alexander, and probably of the same clan, emigrated to America during the different periods of her colonial history, sometimes in single families, and sometimes in groups of families, and settled at various points along the Eastern coast from Nova Scotia on the North to the Carolinas on the South, but the settlements were principally in Pennsylvania. From these first settlements they became so widely dispersed that families of the same name are now found in almost every part of the United States. These families of Alexanders have been nearly all strict Presbyterians in religion, Scotch in nationality, and strongly characterized by the well known peculiarities of that intelligent, hardy, industrious, and liberty-loving people. The evidence is strongly in favor of the conclusion that they were originally of the same Scottish clan, yet owing to their long separation, partly in the old countries before emigration, and partly in the new, where they arrived at different times and places, it is difficult to determine anything definite concerning the degrees of consanguinity -this has been found to be the case in tracing several of the earlier Alexander families who came to America from the same parts of the British Isles, and no certain knowledge of relationship has been found to exist between them. They all came to this country, hoping that by a change of residence. to find an unrestrained field for the exercise of their industry and skill, and for the enjoyment of their religious opinions. They brought with them the hatred of oppression and the love of freedom in its fullest measure, as was afterwards manifested in our struggle for independence.

SKETCH OF ALEXANDER ALEXANDER.

EXANDER ALEXANDER was born in County Down, Ireland, in the year 1731, and married to Miss Agnes Kelly, of Dromore, in the same County, in 1767. Soon after his marriage he decided to cast his lot among the inhabitants of the New World, but his father-inlaw looked upon America as a wilderness, inhabited only by the untutored savages, so he interposed and would not give his consent for his daughter to leave her comfortable home to seek another she knew not of. Feeling that in the course of time his father-in-law would relent, Alexander concealed his cherished hopes and plans and concluded to remain in his native land until a more favorable opportunity would present itself. Years rolled on, but without any encouragement to him whose heart was fixed on an imaginary home in another land, so in the year 1770 he bade his wife and two children (Joseph and John) farewell, expecting to see them soon again, and came to America alone. He first settled in the Conococheague Settlement, in the fertile Cumberland Valley, inhabited principally by those of his own descent, Scotch-Irish. The territory west of the Tuscarora mountains having been recently acquired by the provincial government, settlers eagerly sought and possessed these lands, and Alexander was found among these early pioneers. He formed the acquaintance of William McConnell, the founder of McConnellsburg, and, on the 18th day of November, 1772, purchased from him a tract of land situate in Wells Valley, which afterwards proved to be the best farm in the Valley. After making his purchase, a spirit of independence manifested itself, he felt that he could well support himself and family and must have them with him, so in the following year he returned to his native land, but only to find his father-in-law as obstinate as ever. Defeated in his purpose, but not disheartened, he remained a short time when he again left his wife and children and returned

to his newly acquired possessions in America, where he improved his lands with the fully determined purpose of making it a home for himself and family.

In accordance with the laudable custom of early times, that every person must learn some useful trade, Alexander learned that of a weaver, a trade especially in demand in Ireland, where the linen industry was so extensively carried on, and which in the newly settled portions of this country was almost indispensable, as the settlers raised their flax and wool, and, with the spinning-wheel, loom and needle, converted them into articles of apparel. It is known that after his first arrival in this country, Alexander worked at his trade and that by his thrift and economy he saved enough to purchase his farm and supply his necessary wants.

It is said that in the early part of the year 1774 Alexander conceived the idea that he must go to Philadelphia, but why he should go there, he could not imagine, as there was no reason he could assign for the impression thus formed; nevertheless, the impression grew so strong that one morning he started and made his way to Philadelphia. Whether this story is a mere fiction or not, it is a fact that on the morning of his arrival in the City of Brotherly Love, a vessel reached that port, and seeing many persons approaching the wharf he joined them, and, to his surprise, the first persons whom he recognized were his wife and children. It seems that his father-in-law had either died, or consented that his daughter should join her husband, and she had started on her trip without having advised her husband of her intentions. Alexander and his family immediately sought his new home where he erected a comfortable cabin and had cleared many of his acres, and was there permanently established as the first settler of Wells Valley, soon after which his third child (Elizabeth) was born. [See frontispiece with spot marked where Alexander's first dwelling was erected.]

In 1775 the troubles with our mother country caused the provincial government to withdraw much of the support and protection given to the frontier settlers, and the Indians soon become acquainted with the fact. A gloomy outlook presented itself to these daring pioneers, so Alexander, with his

family and personal effects, left his home and sought safety in the Conococheague Settlement, and while in this place of retreat, in 1780, his fourth child (Christiana) was born. For about six years after Alexander left his home very little of his family history can be obtained, but from Pennsylvania Archives, second series, Vol. 1, we find that on May 1, 1776, an Alexander Alexander enlisted and was assigned to the Armed Boat Chatham, and on October 14, 1776, was transferred to the Fire Brig Vesuvius, and on February 1, 1777, was transferred to the Armed Boat Hancock, but the records fail to give the date of his discharge or the descriptive roll of the men on these Boats. These Armed Boats were not in the national service, but appear to have been under the provincial government, as they are published in the Archives under the head of "Pennsylvania in the Revolution." While there is nothing definitely known to show that the Alexander Alexander above referred to was our ancestor. still there is reason to believe that such is the case, as he was a refugee from his home and could not return in safety until the troubles with our mother country were settled, and it is reasonable to suppose that he enlisted in order that he might aid in terminating the war, further the name Alexander Alexander is a very uncommon one, and further his family was in the Cumberland Valley, from which many enlisted as soldiers and sailors in the struggle for independence. Alexander's family remained in the Conococheague Settlement until the summer of 1781, when, thinking all danger past. he again entered upon his possessions in Wells Valley and put out his fall crops, but in July, 1782, reports of Indian depredations along the frontier were circulated, so he again fled for refuge taking with him his family and movable effects, leaving a field of wheat almost ready for the sickle; on this occasion he fled to McConnell's Cove. Alexander's fears were soon fully realized, as on August 8th the Indians murdered George Peck and his wife and two children near Rays Hill. They then entered the Valley, set fire to Alexander's wheat field, and, after their usual depredations, passed out at the lower end of the Valley, a short distance below which it is said they murdered a family by the name of Benson. In January, 1783, while in McConnell's Cove, the fifth child (Agnes) was born and in

the same year, peace having been declared, Alexander, with his family and personal effects, returned to the Valley, took possession of his property and lived the remainder of his days in peace.

The characteristics of the descendents of the Scotch who settled in the North of Ireland have been such as fit them for the work of pioneers, for the leadership of men in peace and war, and for any work in which the essential qualities of stalwart manhood are required.

The subject of this sketch was a man of indomitable will, whom no obstacle could hinder otherwise than temporarily, whom no burden could crush, and who, because of his almost illimitable resources of mind, succeeded in accomplishing his purpose in the end. Religiously he was a thorough Scotch-Irishman, possessing that unalterable conviction as to matters religious that he had inherited from his forefathers, having a scrupulous conscience, a willingness to perform any duty that might devolve upon him; liberal almost to prodigality, where religious matters were concerned, he esteemed no sacrifice too great if made in the name and for the blue banner of Presbyterianism. Very little is known of his early life and training, but his subsequent life demonstrates the fact that such training had not been neglected, for no sooner had he gathered his family around him in his new forest home than we learn that he is one of the first Elders in the Presbyterian Church of the Great Cove, and on which he was a regular attendant until the time of his death. The Church was located two miles South of the site of McConnellsburg, and when we consider the fact that he and his family had fortyfour miles to travel to reach his place of worship and return home, and the only mode of travel in those days was on horse-back, and, it is said, he never missed a service, it is not surprising that he was noted for his zeal and religious convictions. Politically, he abhorred shams and unrighteousness and ever loved truth and justice. In society he knew no distinctions, save those of honesty and dishonesty and belief and unbelief. To those who did not know him, he might have been reckoned an austere man, while to his familiars he was the embodiment of courtesy and possessed a tenderness like unto the tenderness of woman. He was ever an important and prominent personage in his com-

munity, and men ever looked up to him for guidance where conscience was concerned. He and his peers subdued the wilderness, conquered the savages and laid the foundation of our great and grand old Commonwealth.

After a long, varied, exciting and useful life, he peacefully closed his eyes in death at his residence in Wells Valley, on November 8, 1815, and his remains were interred in the burial lot on his premises, reserved by him in his will. [See frontispiece showing his grave.] In conclusion it can be said of him, in the words of the poet,

> "He ever shed about him the heat of a large and liberal soul; He was not only true but truth, and such that never dies."

ALEXANDER ALEXANDER'S WILL.

N the name of God, Amen. On this 21st day of August, A. D. 1815, I, Alexander Alexander, of the township of Hopewell and county of Bedford, being weak in body, but of perfect mind and memory, calling to mind the shortness and uncertainty of my time, and knowing that it is appointed for all men to die and after death to come the judgment, do make and ordain this my last will and testament.

And first of all, I recommend my soul to God who gave it, and my body I recommend to the earth to be buried in a decent Christian manner, at the discretion of my executors; and, as touching such worldly estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me with in this life, I give and dispose of in the following way and manner:

I leave to my son John and my son Joseph's children a tract of land now in possession of my son John and my son Joseph's widow, to be equally divided, the division line as far as made to stand. I also leave another small tract, to be divided in like manner, to my son John and my son Joseph's children; Joseph's widow is to live on the land now in her possession, with her children, during the time she is my son Joseph's lawful widow, reserving a piece of the aforesaid small tract, the line to run from where Joseph Edwards' potato patch was, nearly upon the top of the ridge, till it intersected the other line, the same piece of the small tract I leave to my daughter Elizabeth Ready, and also the tract of land whereon William Ready now lives to pertain and belong to her during her life, and at her death to belong to her natural heirs.

I leave to my son John what land appears fit for meadow, above the old meadow, up to a marked white oak; he is not to stop the old water course from watering the old meadow.

To my daughter Agnes, I leave one hundred acres, with the usual allowance, to be laid off the lower end of my old place, as my executors think best.

To my daughter Mary, I leave a tract of land formerly occupied by Adam Ports, and in addition I allow the whole long field to go to the Ports' place, and to throw it there by two direct lines I marked when William Alexander was along.

To my daughter Sarah, I leave one hundred acres of land, with the usual allowance, to be laid off at the West end of my land, but it is not to extend farther East than the clearing on the level ridge. To my daughter Christiana, I leave the remainder of my land.

After paying my just debts and funeral expenses and the costs of administration, I leave the balance of my personal estate to my daughter Christiana. And I do reserve from sale or any incumbrances forever forty feet in length and twelve feet in breadth, including my burying ground and timber sufficient for posts and rails to enclose in said burying ground, forever.

I do appoint William Alexander, of Ayr township, and my son John Alexander to be my lawful executors, revoking all former wills, and by these presents ratify and confirm this my last will and testament.

In witness hereof, I have set my hand and seal the day and year above written.

Signed and sealed in the presence of us. WM. K. ALEXANDER, ANDREW ALEXANDER.

DEED, WILLIAM M'CONNELL TO ALEXANDER ALEXANDER.

NOW ye all men by these presents, that I, William McConnell, Esq., of Ayr township & County of Bedford, have Bargained & sold, & do by these presents make Over a Certain Tract of Land located by lying in Aughwick Valley, on the small Branch leading into the Aughwick waters, about three miles from the Great Road on the Top of Sideling Hill, on a small Road from sideling hill leading to the Juniata; Containing about Two Hundred & Eighty Acres, unto Alexander Alexander, of Antrim Township & County of Cumberland, for and in Consideration of the sum of thirty Pounds, Lawful Money of Pennsylvania, paid, the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, and I do hereby Warrant & Defend said Tract of Land unto him, the said Alexander, his heirs & Assigns, forever, from Persons Claiming from, by, or under me, as Witness my hand and seal this Eighteenth Day of November in the year of Our Lord One Thousand seven Hundred & seventy-two. 1772.

THE Aughwick Valley above referred to is now Wells Valley, Fulton county, Pennsylvania, the Great road is the State road, and the small road is the road leading from the State road to Hopewell. The land included in the above conveyance is now owned by George A. Stewart, Mrs. Alexander Gibson, Wm. H. Spangler, Samuel P. Wishart and Harvey Wishart, and on the portion owned by the latter is the site of Alexander Alexander's first dwelling and his grave.
