KAPPA DELTA EPSILON

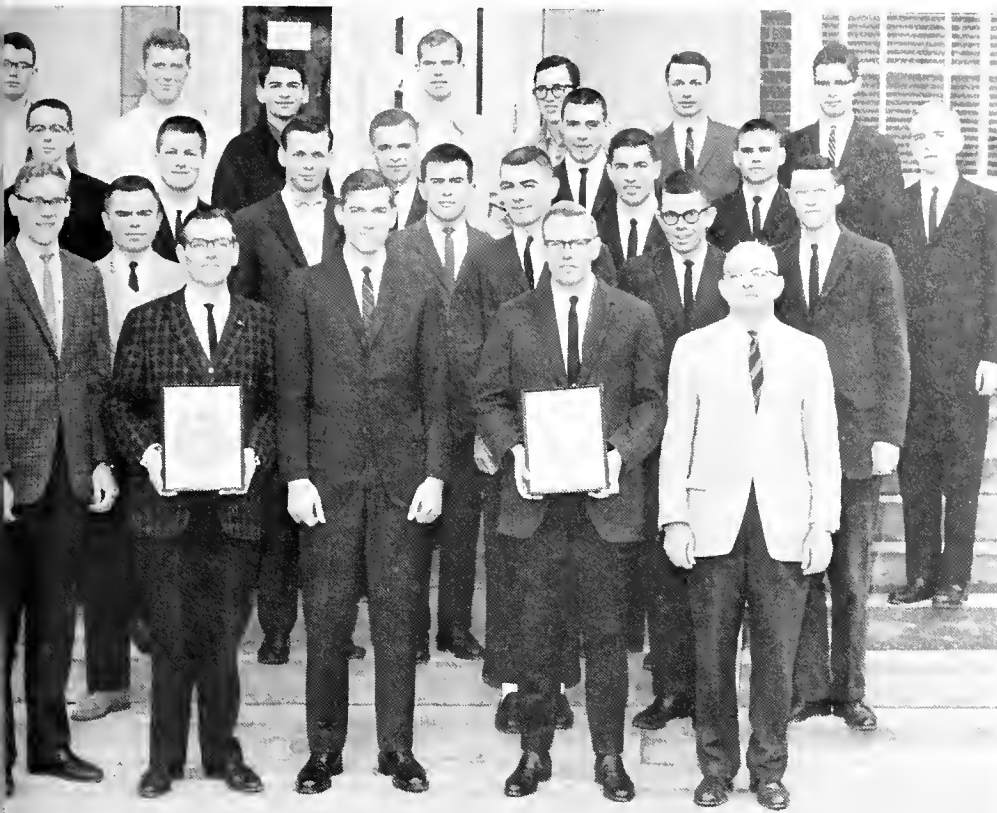

AMERICAN CHEMICAL SOCIETY AND THETA CHI DELTA

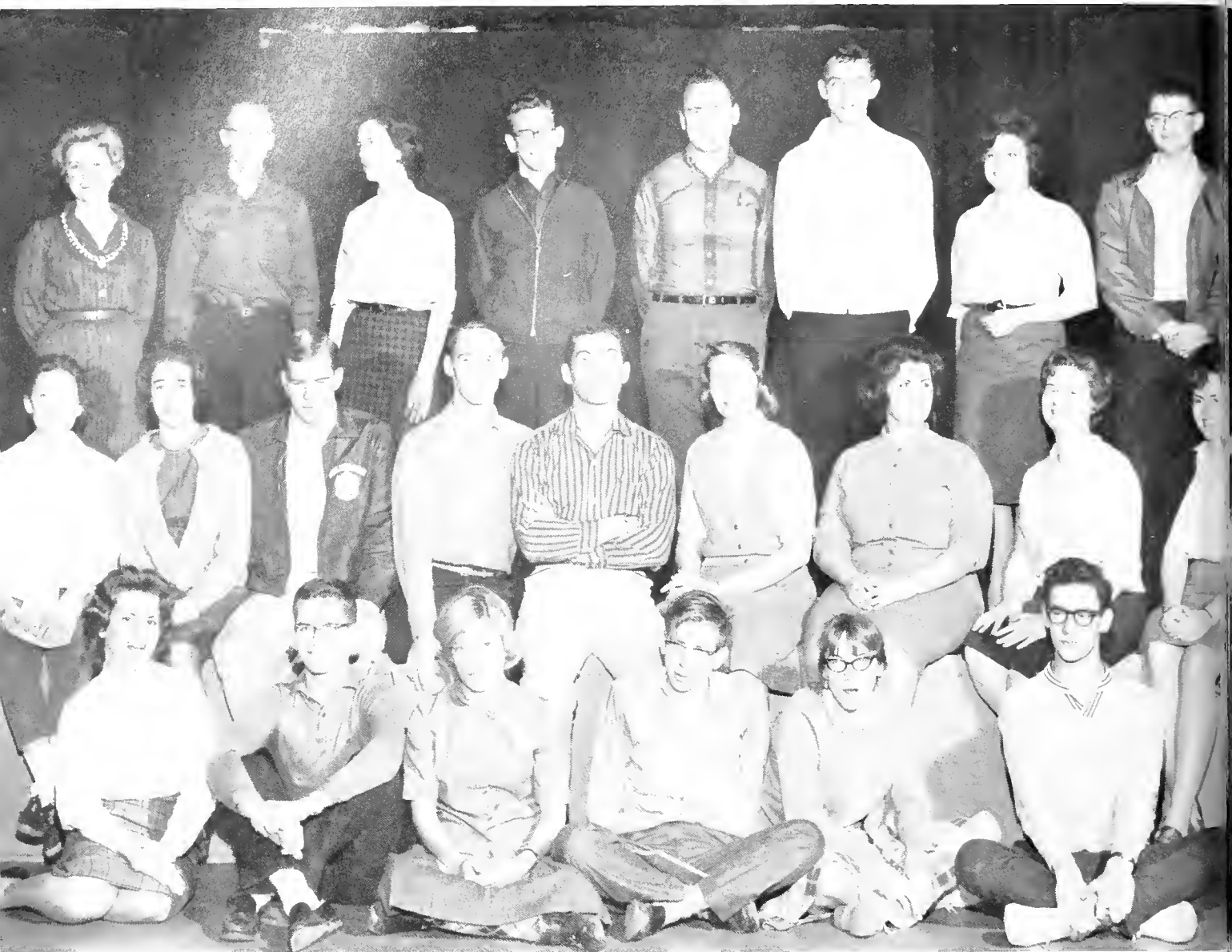

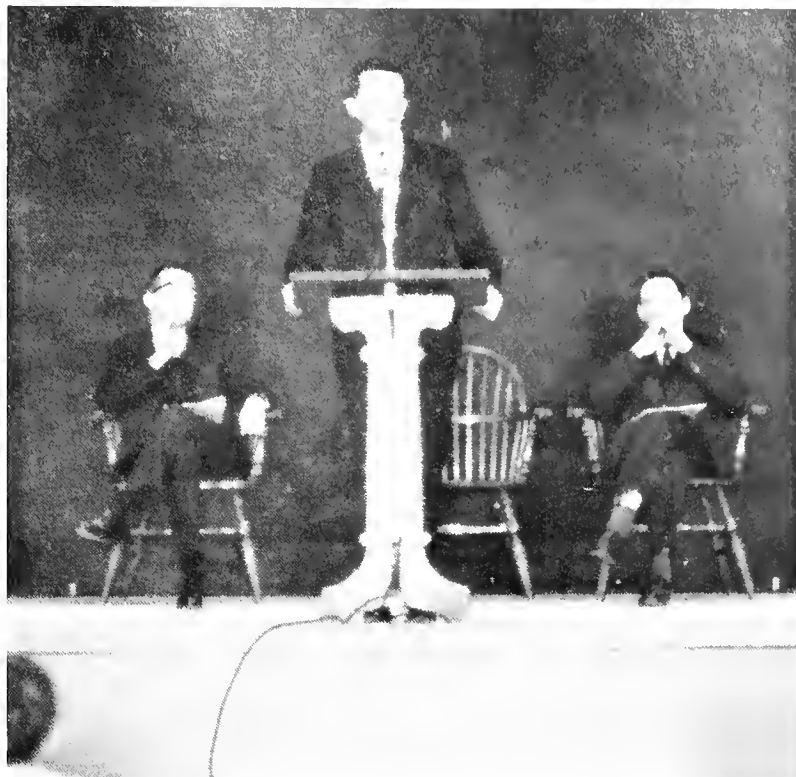
PHI CHI THETA

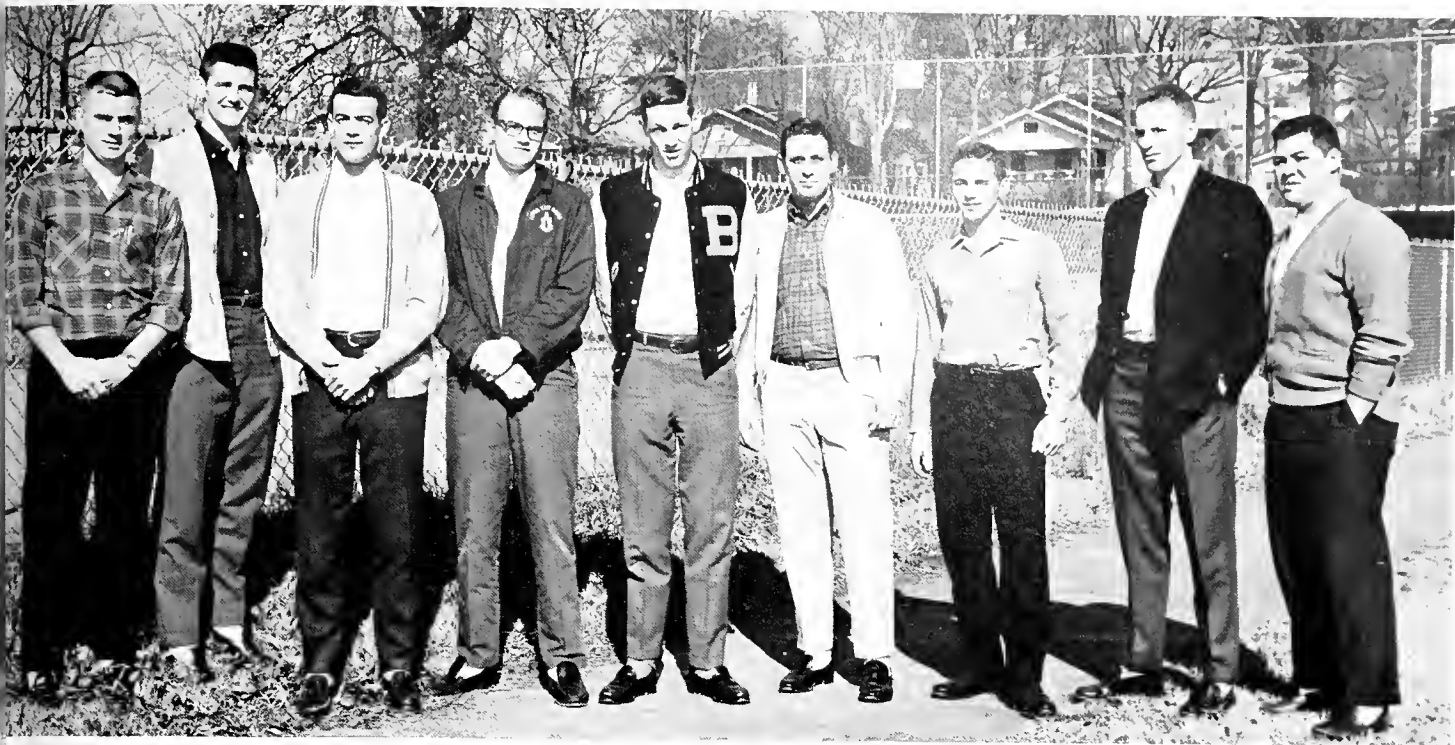
MEN'S INTRAMURAL COUNCIL
