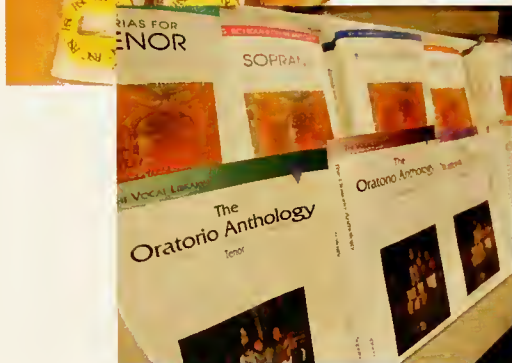

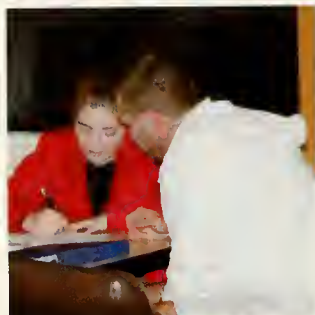

Above: Matt Tucker stops by the convenience store to pick up a late-night snack. The convenience store is now located in the Cellar where the coffee house was located last year.

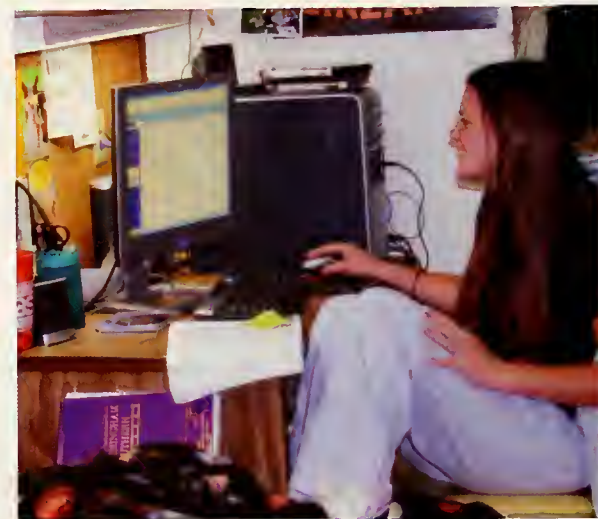

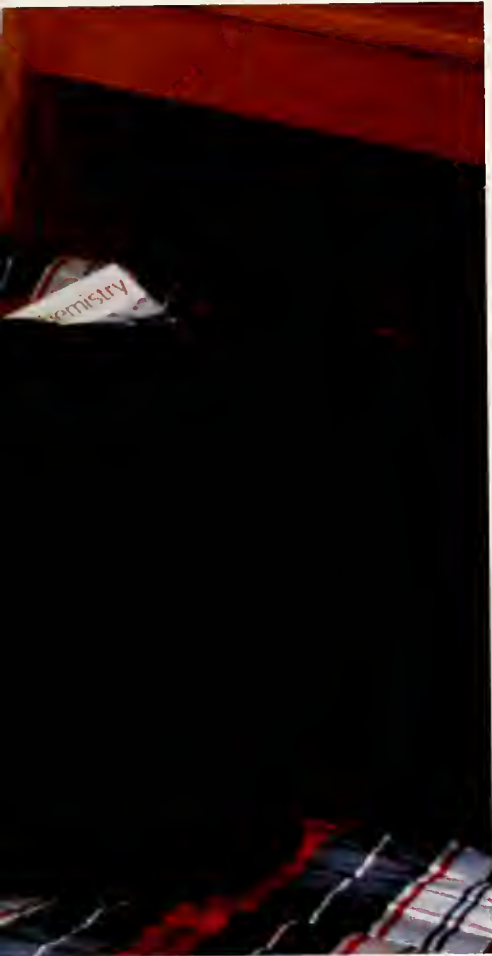

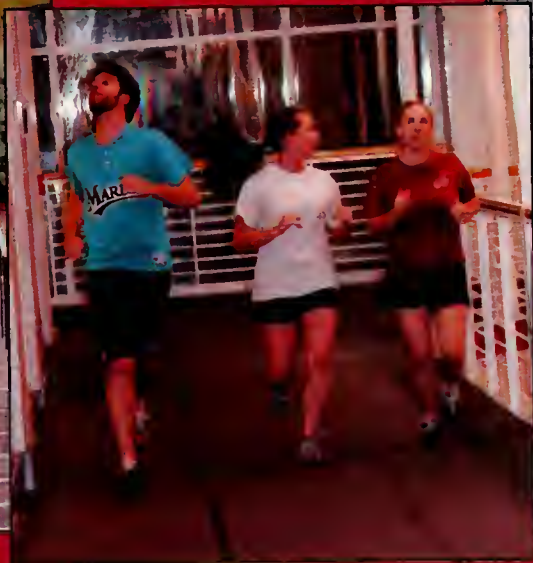

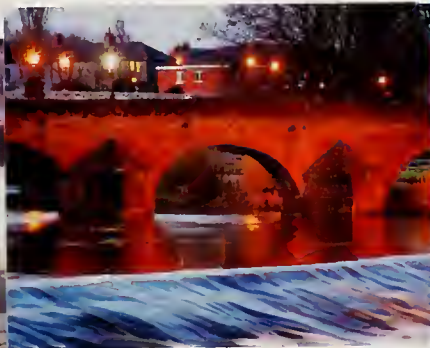

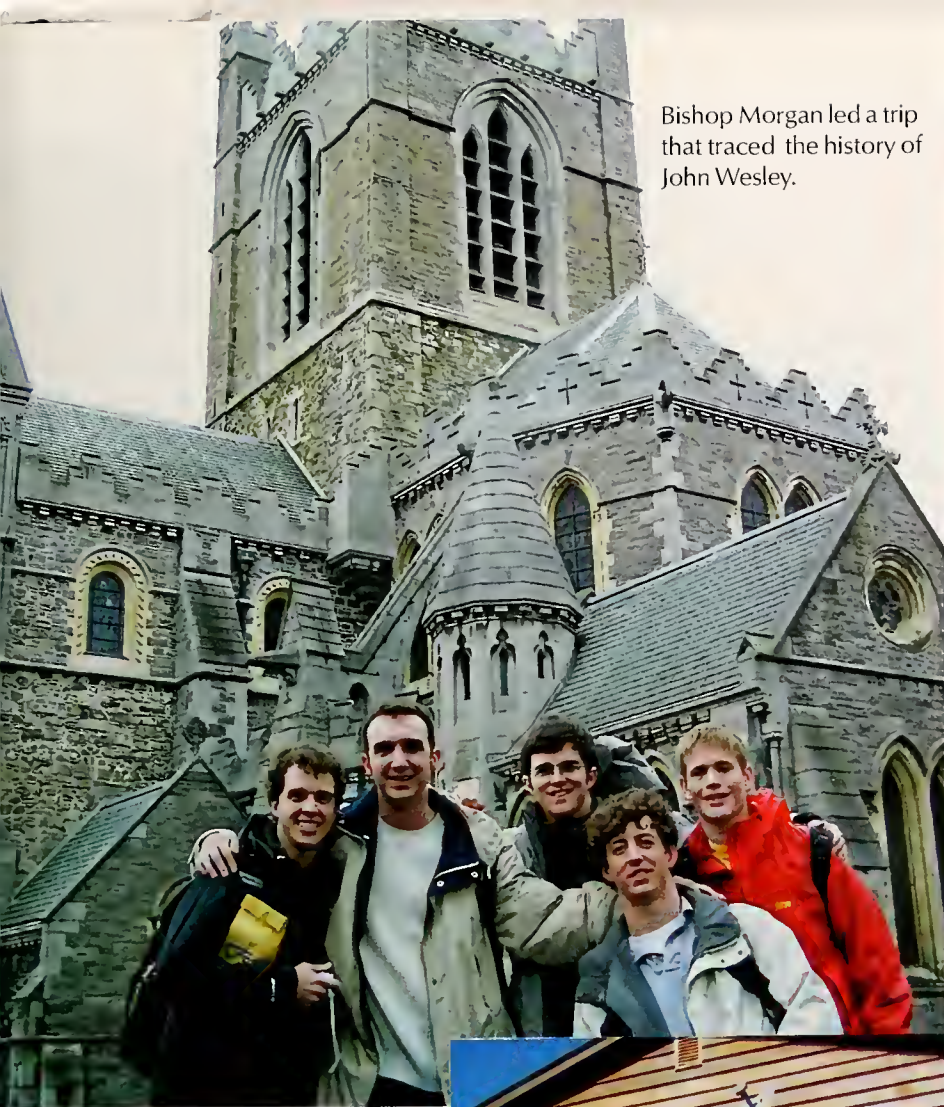

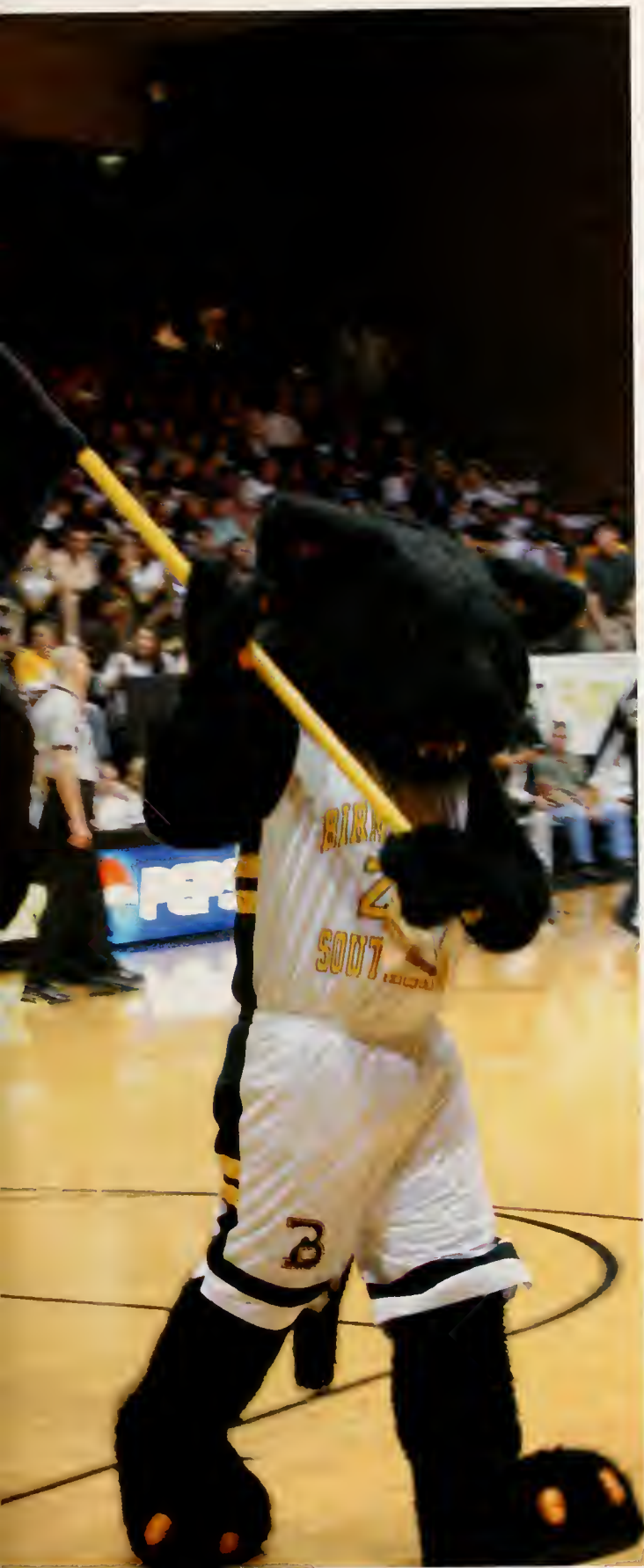

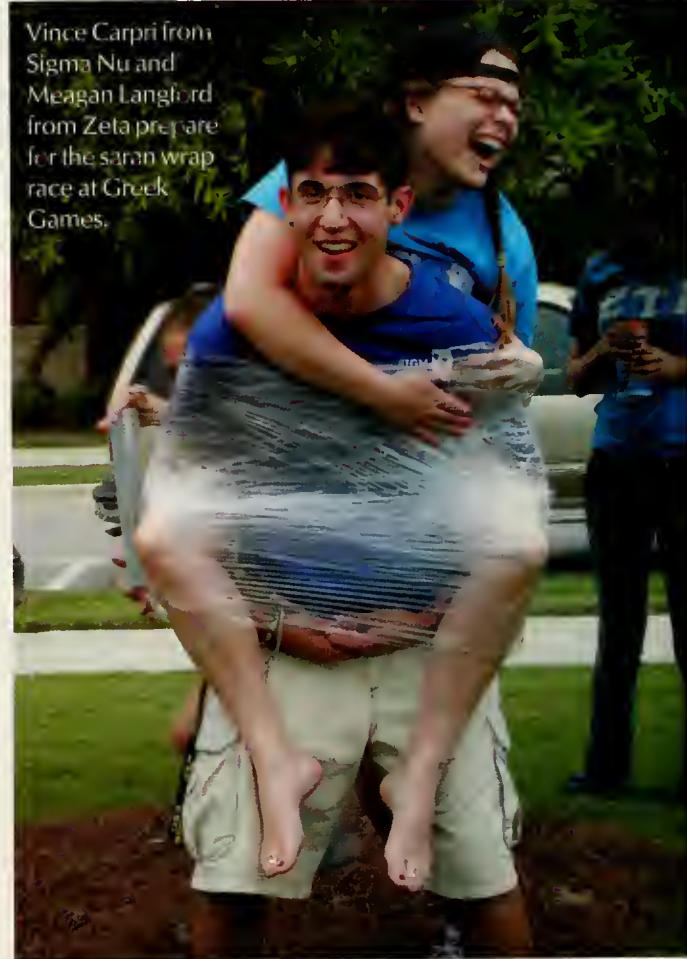

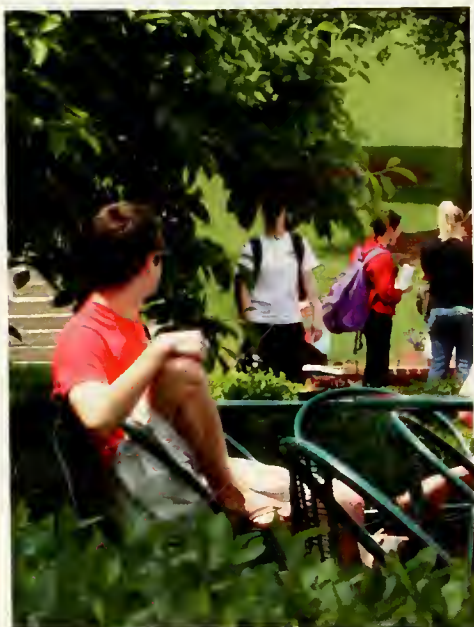


Chi Omega Molly Cowley triumphantly raises her hand after winning the bubble gum in a pie contest. She was the first to find her gum ball in the whipped cream.

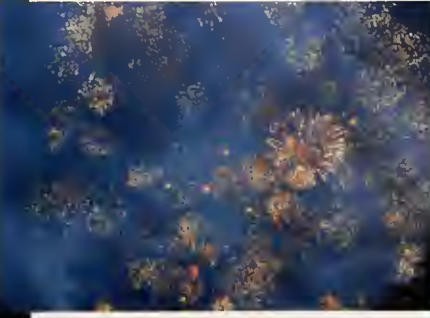

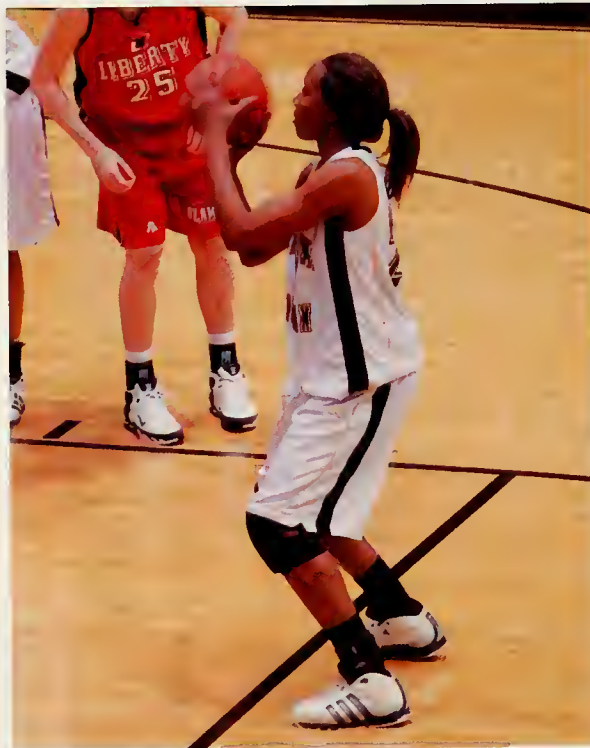

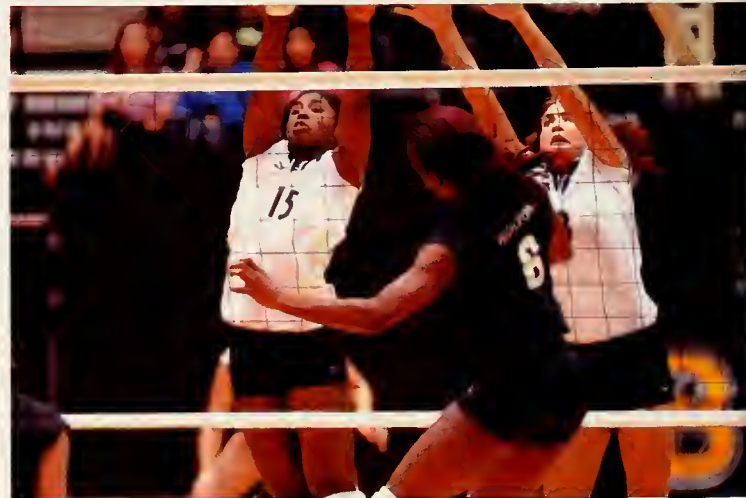

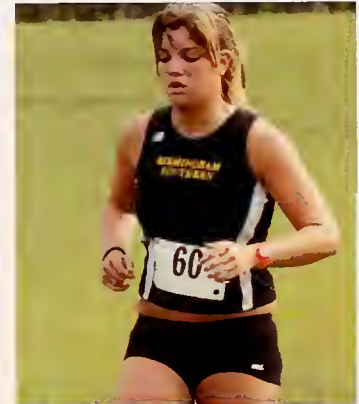

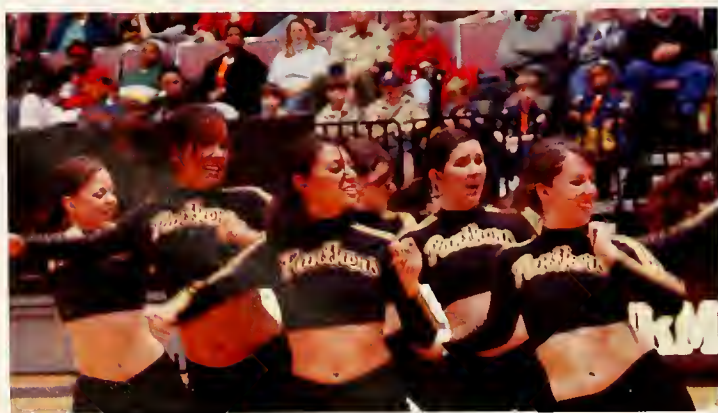

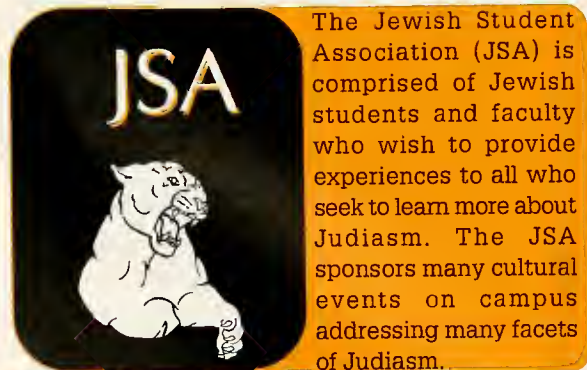

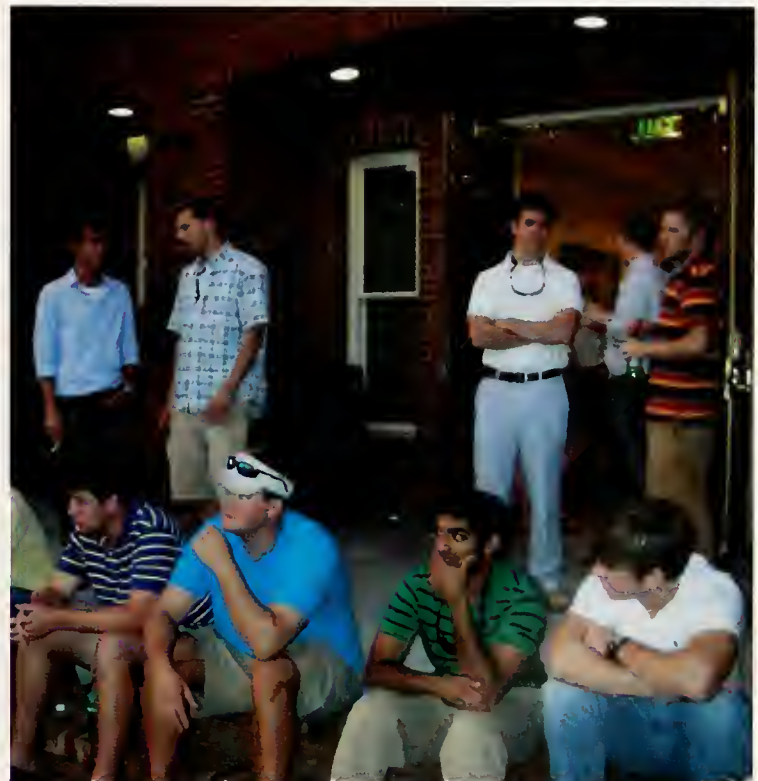
