

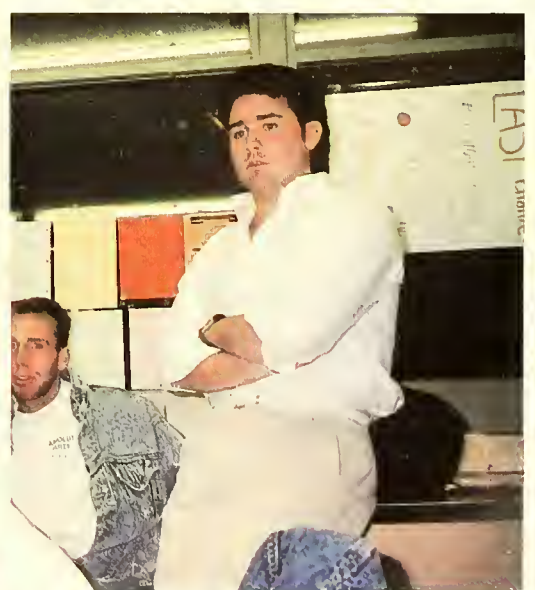

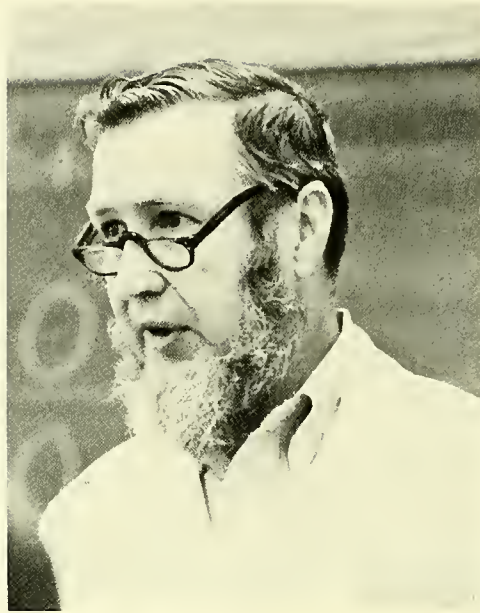

Always dear they'll be.

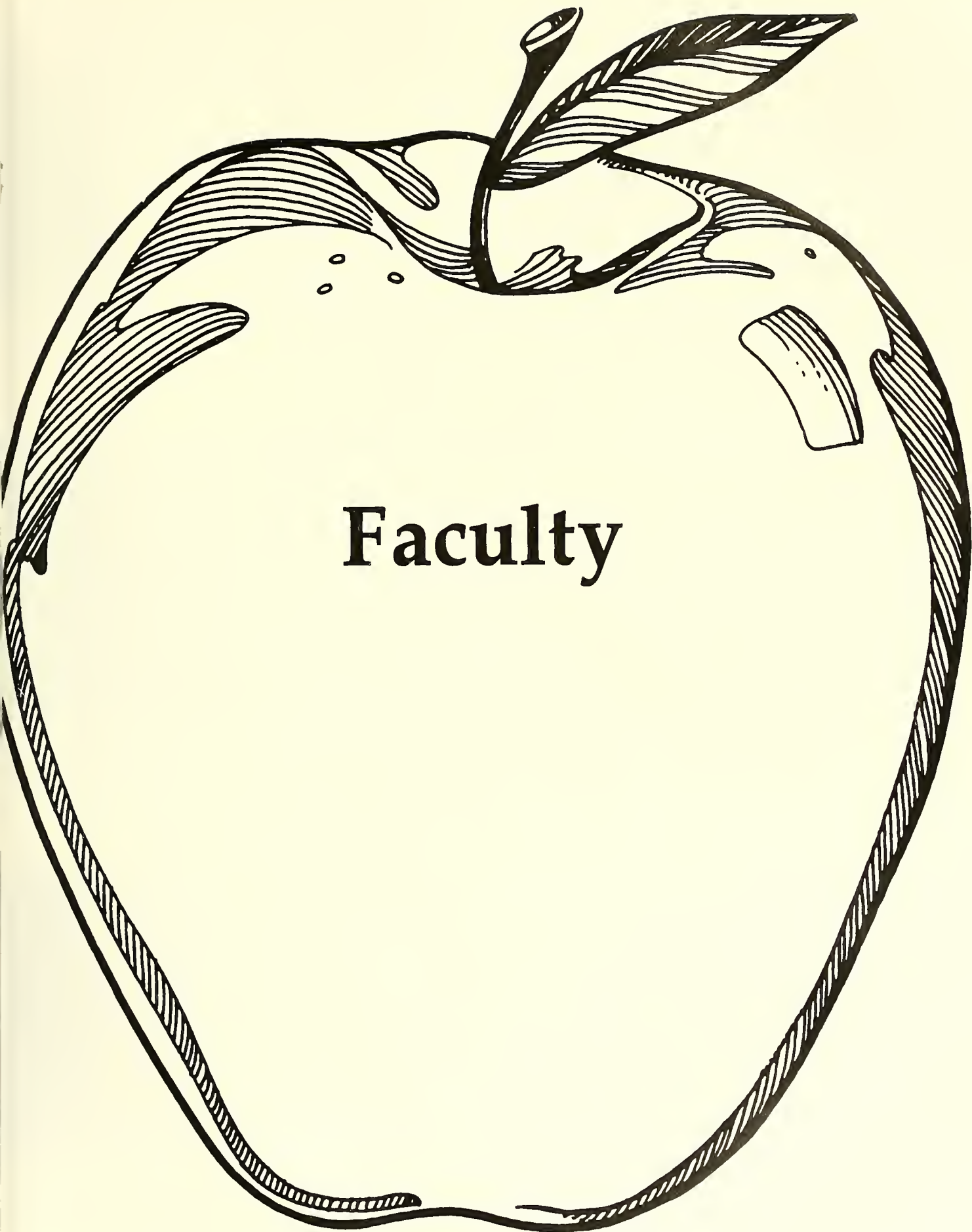
