I will be ever alert to adhere to and develop the principles of Osteopathy as taught by Andrew Taylor Still.



At that time, an Editorial Board, consisting of Terry Hall, '54, Brian Herdeg, '54, and Duane Tucker, '54, was appointed. Their term ended in October, '53, when Bob DeRue, '56, and Jim Chimerakis, '56, became temporary Co-Editors. The current Editor-in-Chief is Jim Chimerakis, '56.

The AXONE underwent a metamorphosis in February, 1954, when it became a pocket-size news magazine. This is particularly notable since, in 1922, the first AXONE was also a magazine, just twice the size of the current publication.
