#### DEAN'S MESSAGE

WHEN TELEVISION WAS IN ITS COMMERCIAL INFANCY, ABOUT 35 YEARS AGO, FEW PEOPLE PROJECTED ITS IMPACT ON OUR SOCIETY. IN FACT, AT THAT TIME, IT PROBABLY WAS MORE OF A LOCAL PHENOMENON BECAUSE THE APPEARANCE OF THE FIRST TELEVISION SET ON THE BLOCK TRIGGERED A GREAT DEAL OF INTERACTION BETWEEN THE OWNER OF THE SET AND THE NEIGHBORS. THE LIVING ROOM SOON BECAME A VIEWING ROOM WITH DOZENS OF PEOPLE STARING AT THE OFTEN BLURRED AND SNOWY IMAGES THAT APPEARED ON THE SMALL BLACK AND WHITE SCREEN. EVEN THE COMMERCIALS WERE THOUGHT TO SIMPLY BE PART OF THE TOTAL ENTERTAINMENT RATHER THAN SOMETHING THAT COULD INFLUENCE THE BEHAVIOR OF MILLIONS OF PEOPLE.

THE ADVENT OF JET-ENGINED COMMERCIAL AIRLINERS, 25 YEARS AGO, CAUSED A TEMPORAL AND MENTAL REDUCTION IN THE DISTANCE BETWEEN CITIES, COUNTRIES, AND CONTINENTS. A LONG AND NOISY FLIGHT IN THE OLD PISTON-ENGINED AIRCRAFT OFTEN LEFT THE TRAVELER SO ENERVATED THAT DOING BUSINESS AFTER ARRIVAL AT A DESTINATION WAS IMPOSSIBLE. TODAY, ONE CAN BREAKFAST IN VIENNA, ATTEND A MEETING IN LONDON, AND HAVE DINNER IN NEW YORK.

YOU ARE NOW IN THE MIDST OF ONE OF THOSE TECHNOLOGICAL BIRTHS AND WILL HAVE THE OPPORTUNITY, 25 YEARS FROM NOW, TO WITNESS ITS IMPACT. MICROCHIPS AND OTHER INNOVATIONS HAVE FREED THE COMPUTER USER FROM THE RESTRICTIONS IMPOSED BY THE USE OF LARGE MAIN FRAME COMPUTERS. THE PERSONAL MICROCOMPUTER AND THE MINICOMPUTERS ARE RAPIDLY CHANGING HOW EACH OF US, BOTH AS A CONSUMER AND A HEALTH PROFESSIONAL, HANDLE INFORMATION AND DATA. SINCE YOUR FUTURE PRIVATE AND PROFESSIONAL LIFE WILL BE SO DEPENDENT ON THE USE OF THOSE NEW FANGLED CONTRAPTIONS, YOU MUST ACTIVELY CONTINUE YOUR EDUCATION IN THE COMPUTER SCIENCES. MANY PERSONS APPROACH CONTINUING EDUCATION IN A PASSIVE MANNER, BUT YOU WILL NEED TO AGGRESSIVELY SEEK OUT COMPUTER USE COURSES AND PROGRAMS IF YOU WANT TO COMPETE AS A HEALTH PROFESSIONAL DURING YOUR FUTURE CAREER.
