Introduction

IN publishing the Registers of a Parish, those of my readers who are familiar with old records will scarcely find fault with me for adhering to the original spelling; though, possibly, others may consider me harsh—not to say, barbarous—and may be inclined to quote:—

“Barbarus hic ego sum quia non intelligor ulli.”

Still a strict adherence to the original appears the only correct way to print a work of this kind; and this method I have accordingly followed.

The parish (the Registers of which are here submitted to the public eye) is situated about four miles West of Royston, and nearly eleven South of Cambridge. It is variously called Abington-in-the-Clay, Abington Pigotts, and Abington-juxta-Shingay, the last form being especially used in these Register-books. It is in the Hundred of Armingford, and in the Deanery of Shingay.

The Church consists of a square tower at the West end, a Nave with South porch, and a Chancel. It is dedicated to S. Michael and All Angels, and the living is valued in the King's books at £16. 2s. 3½*d.* The architecture of the Chancel is late of the thirteenth century, and that of the rest of the Church early of the fourteenth century.

When the Church was re-roofed in 1865, a fresco over the roodloft (which latter had been destroyed before the memory of man) was brought to light by carefully clearing off the whitewash of many years; but a storm of rain one night while the roof was off, so obliterated it as to prevent its being restored. The fresco was worked in blue and red stencilling, and represented; to the right of spectator, the good, in the company of angels, going up steps into heaven; and to the left, the wicked being thrust into flames with forks held by demons.

Volume I. of the Registers is of parchment, and commences with the appointment of a Registrar on the ninth day of January, 1653-[4]. It is fairly legible—with the exception of two pages, which have suffered from damp—and perfect, but half of the first page is cut cleanly off, so that the name of the magistrate, who signed the appointment of the Registrar is missing. I have no doubt that, as this officer was sworn at Whaddon, a neighbouring village, Sir Henry Pickering, who then owned it, was the Justice of the Peace who

officiated. The volume consists of twenty-two leaves, or forty-four pages; size, nine inches by five-and-a-half inches. The lower outer corner of another leaf has also been torn away, and about a third of one more cut off. There are no entries in 1679, and one only in 1678, though space has been left in each case.

Vol. II. is also of parchment. It begins in 1729, where Vol. I. leaves off, and is continued till 1782, being throughout well kept and legible; size, about nine by six inches. Twenty leaves, of which one, and the half of another, are not filled up.

Vol. III. again of parchment, begins in 1782 and ends in 1812; size about thirteen inches by eight. It contains fourteen leaves, or twenty-eight pages, of which eleven are not filled up.

Vol. IV., devoted to Marriages and Banns of Marriage, is of paper, commencing in 1755 and ending in 1811. This Register was provided in compliance with the Statute popularly known as "Lord Hardwicke's Act," of which some particulars may be seen at page 90.

Stitched into Vol. I. is an interesting list of Briefs, followed by a statement of the money collected (pp. 34-38). Four paper leaves have been folded, and thus make sixteen long and narrow pages, on which the entries have been written.

When an account of the Registers belonging to the Parish was returned by order to Government in 1813, the first Register ending in 1729 was missing. Of the

date or circumstances of its restoration to the Parish Chest there is no record. The Rev. George Pennington, vicar of Bassingbourne and curate of Abington in 1813, who furnished the return above mentioned, makes no allusion to this first Register, though the others are duly enumerated in his own hand in the present Baptismal Registers.

With these few remarks I present to the public the Registers of Abington Pigotts or Abington-juxta-Shingay. I cannot conclude, however, without saying that my best thanks are due to Mr. John A. C. Vincent, a well-known worker at the Public Record Office, for his valuable assistance in deciphering those parts of the first volume which had been injured by damp, or were otherwise difficult, and also for his further help in seeing the present work through the press.

¹ Or, as otherwise written with a double date, 1653-4; being the January immediately following the 4th of August 1653. It is well, perhaps, that attention should be called thus early to the distinction between the HISTORICAL and the LEGAL year, because both styles are used in this Register. The Historical year has for a very long period begun on the 1st of January, but the Civil, Ecclesiastical, and Legal year commenced (in and after the 14th century) on the 25th of March, and so continued until the Calendar was corrected by Statute (24 Geo. II. c. 23) in 1751, and the legal year ordered to begin on the first of January in 1752, and so on from time to time in every year after.

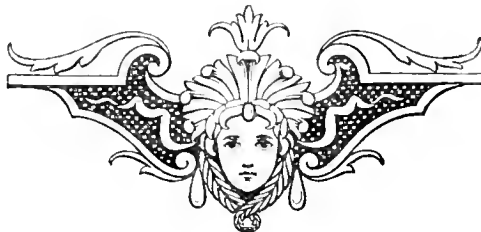

The handwriting of Andrew Pern, who was inducted Rector 15th Jan., 1740-1, now appears, and the Baptisms and Burials of 1740 are attested by him, "*Sic desinit Annus 1740, A. Pern, Rector.*" The Registers for 1741 and 1742 are in another hand, the same person who began the Registers in 1729. Andrew Pern again appears in 1743, and from that date "*to Baptiz^d 1758,*" all the entries are in his writing. But there are only two Baptisms in 1758, no entry of Marriage or Death. The Register then goes on "Baptized 1759," and the two Deaths registered that year with the Baptisms are in another hand. Then A. Pern begins again "Oct. 19, 1760, William Abby," &c.—W. G. F. P.

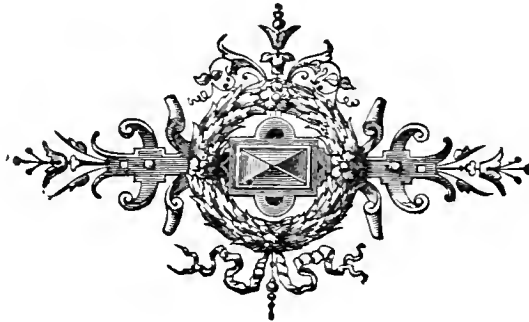

An Act¹ for the better preventing of Clandestine Marriages.
(A.D. 1753)

(14) "And for preventing undue entries and abuses in registers of marriages; be it enacted by the authority aforesaid, That on or before the twenty-fifth day of *March* in the year one thousand seven hundred and fifty-four, and from time to time afterwards as there shall be occasion, the church-wardens and chapel-wardens of every parish or chapelry shall provide proper books of vellum, or good and durable paper, in which all marriages and banns of marriage respectively, there published or solemnized, shall be registered . . . and shall be signed by the parson, vicar, minister or curate, . . . and all books provided as aforesaid shall be deemed to belong to every such parish or chapelry respectively, and shall be carefully kept and preserved for publick use."

(15) "And in order to preserve the evidence of marriages, . . . be it enacted, That from and after the twenty-fifth day of *March* in the year one thousand seven hundred and fifty-four, all marriages shall be solemnized in the presence of two or more credible witnesses, besides the minister who shall celebrate the same; and that immediately after the celebration of every marriage, an entry thereof shall be made in such register to be kept as aforesaid; in which entry or register it shall be expressed, That the said marriage was celebrated by banns or licence; . . . and shall be signed by the minister with his proper addition, and also by the parties married, and attested by such two witnesses."²

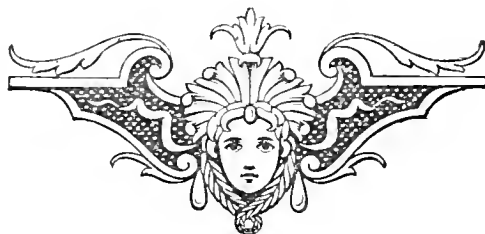

1292-3, Jan. 27. **William de Essewell.** Admitted on the presentation of William Pichard, as appears by the Final

III. m. 2 (or 14); 41 Hen. III. m. 1; 4 Edw. III. n^o 37; 11, 12, 13 Ric. II. n^o 12). Here is at once a fruitful source of confusion. Little Abington, though plainly described in the bishop's certificate as a *Vicarage*, and in the Deanery of *Camps*, has been twice erroneously calendared under "Abington juxta Shingay," which is a Rectory and in the Deanery of Shingay. Again, even in the Bishops' Certificates (Ely), Abington juxta Shingay or Abington Pigotts is twice (1672 and 1680-1), by inadvertence, certified to be in the Deanery of *Camps*, which (as above stated) is the ecclesiastical division containing the other two Abingtons. From and after the year 1554 Cole's list—for such it may be called, by reason of his adopting it and making it his own—can be checked by the "Bishops' Certificates" and "Composition Books," preserved among the Records of the Exchequer. His omissions of Rectors from and including that date are shown by an asterisk (*) placed before the name; and, generally, his statements have been freely dealt with in the way of correction or enlargement.

² In 1374 one Richard, perpetual chaplain of the chapel of Saint Swithin in Abington, took at Ely the oath of obedience to Bishop Arundel, as appears by an extract made by Cole (*Add. MS.* 5842, p. 10) from that bishop's register. On the death of this Richard—whose surname was Godred—he was succeeded by Thomas Chalmington, between whom and Robert, vicar of Steeple Morden, disputes arose concerning tithes, which resulted in an action for trespass brought before the king's justices at Westminster in 1392. The chaplain stated in defence, that there had been, from time immemorial, a free chapel within the manor of Dounhalle and parish of Abington, to which, on every avoidance, the lords of that manor nominated a chaplain, who was then presented to the vicar of Steeple Morden, and by him instituted; and that these chaplains had all tithes except those of corn and hay. The vicar contended that the chapel and the tenants of the fee, to which the manor was subject, belonged to the parish of Steeple Morden; and that the chaplain was removeable at the will of the vicar for the time being. The matters in dispute, as falling within the cognizance of an ecclesiastical court, were referred by the king's writ, dated 8 July 1392, to the bishop of Ely, who was commanded to make inquiry and to report the result to the justices at York on the 13th of October following (*Add. MS.* 5825, f. 191).

- 1380, Oct. 2. **William Gysors.** From S. Pancras¹ [in Soper Lane now Queen Street], London. Had leave of absence for two years in 1383.
- 1392, Nov. 26. **John Ferybrigg.** Succeeded on the death of William Gysors; presented this turn by Joan Haselden.
- 1440, April 8. **John Cooper, M.A.** Presented by the venerable man, John Pygott.
- 1447, Oct. 28 [or 31]. The Venerable Father **William, Bishop of Dunkeld.** By exchange for Halynby with John Cooper. He was Suffragan of the Bishop of Ely, and had the Hospital of SS. John Baptist and Mary Magdalen, Ely, in 1454. Presented by John Pigot.
1473. Master **John Sparhawke, S.T.P.,** resigned. Thomas Pygott and his seoffees presented.
- 1473, Aug. 20. **John Pigott.** Succeeded on the resignation of John Sparhawke. By his will, dated 12 Dec. 1479, he bequeathed his body to be buried in the Chancel of S. Michael, Abington; and gave (*inter alia*) 3s. 4d. in money to the convent of Friars Minors in Cambridge.²
1486. **William Penne** resigned.
- 1486-7, Jan. 8. **William Adam.** Presented on the resignation of William Penne by William Cheyne. "In 1486 a Mandate from the Bishop to induct the Rector at the presentation of

On one side of him, in a small scroll of brass still remaining, are the words, *Miserere mei Deus.* There are matrices for three more scrolls, and four circular matrices, one in each corner, about four inches in diameter. This is probably a brass in memory of John Pigott, as it is the only stone that has the reaved effigy of a priest or ecclesiastic.

There is also a very old stone with the portraiture of a man in brass and eight boys at his feet. 1516-17, Jan. 17. **Leonard Cotton**, LL.B. *In commendam* for three months. Instituted 26 April 1517, at the presentation of Thomas Pygott.

1554, June 16. ***William Bradleye**² compounded for first fruits³; his sureties being Robert Thomas of the parish of

³ By “first fruits” understand the profits for one year of every spiritual living, whether benefice or dignity; which profits (anciently given to the pope) were made payable to the king by Statute 26 Hen. VIII. c. 3, from every incumbent or dignitary after his institution, collation, or installation. In the case of Abington Rectory, the first fruits were £14. 10s. 0¼*d.*, which constant sum was found by deducting the yearly tenth (32*s.* 2¾*d.*), which was also given to the king out of all ecclesiastical revenues by the Statute above cited, from the annual value (£16. 2*s.* 3½*d.*), reckoned according to the return made into the Exchequer in the year 1535 (*Valor Ecclesiasticus*, iii. 503). Sometimes the entire first fruits of benefices were paid “in hand,” *i.e.*, at once; but, more generally, four bonds were taken for four half-yearly payments to be made on fixed dates—commonly, the first day of certain months, as February and August, March and September, &c.; but occasionally the usual quarter-days. After 25 March 1704, one bond only was required for the four payments by the Statute 2 and 3 Anne, c. 11 (otherwise c. 20); under which also the first fruits were given up by the Crown and settled upon a corporation, afterwards known as the “Corporation of Queen Anne's Bounty,” which was empowered to administer the revenue arising therefrom for the benefit of the poorer clergy. It may be added that certain clauses in the Statute 26 Hen. VIII. c. 3, have been repealed by the Statute Law Revision Act, 1863 (26 and 27 Victoria, cap. 125).

S. Dunstan in the West, London, merchant tailor, and Thomas Sewster of Whaddon in the county of Cambridge, gentleman. Patron, Henry Pigott, Esq.

1562, April 17. **William Cragge**, M.A., was instituted. He compounded for first fruits on the 24th of June following, his sureties being Henry Pigott of Abington in the county of Cambridge, Esq., and Robert Thomas of the parish of S. Dunstan in the West, London, merchant tailor.

1606, August 5. **John Harrison**, B.D., was instituted to the Rectory of Abington, void by the death of William Cragge, and compounded for first fruits on the 4th of October following. His sureties were Thomas Awdeley of Saint Ives in the county of Huntingdon, Esq., and Whittell Awdeley of Wigan [*sic*] in the same county, gentleman.

1633, Sept. 17. **Edward Lynne**, B.D.,¹ third son of John Lynne of Bassingbourn, Esq., by Mary (Sewster) his wife. Born about Christmas 1570; educated at Eton, whence he was elected to King's College, Cambridge, a Scholar 6 Sept. 1589, and Fellow 6 Sept. 1592. B.A. 1593, M.A. 1597, B.D. 1605. He was instituted to the Rectory of Abington 17 Sept. 1633, at the presentation of Mistress Anne Pigott,² widow, and compounded for first fruits on the 18th³ of October

following, being bound himself with two others, viz, James Storrye of the parish of S. Benet Fink, London, haberdasher, and Thomas Starkey of the parish of S. Laurence Poultney, London, saddler. He made his will¹ (proved—P.C.C. 196 Berkeley—9 May 1656), dated 8 July 1655, at Abington and died there, being buried (p. 3) 8 Nov. 1655. He must have resigned the benefice some ten years before, as may be seen by the date of his successor's institution.

1645, July 23. **Isaac King** was instituted.² He compounded for first fruits on the same day, his sureties being—Henry Pigott of Abington in the county of Cambridge, Esq., and Henry Lynne of Higham Gobion in the county of Bedford, clerk. He was one of the ministers ejected by the Act for Uniformity. See Calamy's (Edmund) *Life of Baxter*, 1702, 8vo. p. 277.

1662, Dec. 23. ***William Walton**, M.A., was instituted at the presentation of John Pigott, Esq. He compounded for first fruits 15 May 1663, his sureties being—Henry Pigott of Abington, aforesaid, Esq., and John Dunham of Moreton [*sic*] in the county of Cambridge, weaver.

1672, March 26. **William Jackson** of St. John's College, M.A., Fellow of Jesus College in 1661, B.D. 1668, D.D. 1673. He was instituted at the presentation of John Pigott, Esq., and compounded for first fruits 26 August 1672, his sureties being Roger Jackson of the Parish of S. Giles in the Fields, Middlesex, gentleman, and John Jackson³ of the parish of S. Dunstan in the West, London, hosier. He was rector also

of Chelmsford¹ in Essex, and prebendary of the Cathedral Church of York. He died in college in the year 1780.—*MSS. Jesus Coll.*, Cambridge.

1680-1, March 14. **Edward Chester**, Fellow of Trinity College, Cambridge. B.A. 1665, M.A. 1669. Instituted at the presentation of John Pigott, Esq. (*see* p. 24.) He compounded for first fruits 18 April 1681, his sureties being—Granado Chester of the parish of S. Helen, London, grocer; and Valentine Castillion of the parish of S. Martin Ludgate, London, grocer. He died 25 Dec. 1705, at . . . in the county of Middlesex (p. 28.)

1704, March 28. **Lionel Coles**, son of John Coles, of Greetham² in Rutlandshire. He was of Clare Hall, B.A. 1686, M.A. 1690, and vicar of Bassingbourn³ in this county. Instituted to Abington at the presentation of Granado Pigott, Esq., he compounded for first fruits of the Rectory 16 May 1704, being bound himself with Richard Davies of Bridewell Precinct, London, hatmaker. His first wife, Ann, died (p. 38) at Westminster, 18 Dec. 1710, and was buried 21 Dec. in the vault of the Savoy Chancel, where he was chaplain. On 12 Dec. 1714 he married secondly, in Lincoln Minster, Leticia Thompson, who survived him and died at Lincoln. He died 26 March, and was buried 30 March 1718, in the middle alley of this church (Abington) near the chancel.

1718, June 25. **Joseph Bentham**, D.D., Fellow of Peterhouse, B.A. 1674, M.A. 1678, D.D. 1696. Presented by Granado Pigott, Esq. He compounded for first fruits 29 April 1719, being bound himself with John Ecton⁴ of Lincoln's Inn, Middlesex, Esq.

1723, Nov. 6. ***Thomas Hewerdine** of Sidney Sussex College, B.A. 1680, M.A. 1684. Presented by Granado Pigott¹ of Bassingbourn in the county of Cambridge, Esq. He compounded for first fruits 6 Nov. 1723, being bound himself with George Torrent of the parish of S. Botolph, Aldgate, London, upholder. He was some time Vicar of Bassingbourn,² and preached in the church on the anniversary of its dedication 14 July 1717, a sermon which was afterwards printed, entitled "The Common Prayer-Book no English Mass-Book," and dedicated to "Granado Pigott, Edward Nightingale, Esquires, and the rest of the gentlemen and parishioners of Bassingbourn and Kneesworth." In the course of the dedication he mentions the fact (found in an old book of Church Wardens' Accounts), that on S. Margaret's Day, 3 Hen. VIII. (20 July 1511), there was acted at Bassingbourn "the Play of the Holy Martyr St. George." At the same time was made a plentiful and free entertainment, towards the charge of which no fewer than twenty-seven of the neighbouring towns contributed. Among these "Abington" is the ninth in the order named,

which was that of paying the respective sums out of their public stocks. Mr. Hewerdine was the author of other tracts, chiefly in defence of infant-baptism.¹ He died in the 82nd year of his age at Bassingbourn, and was buried there 7 Nov. 1740, as appears by the Parish Register.

Andrew Pern Batchelor in Divinity was Instituted to the Rectory of Abington near Shengay in the County of Cambridge and Deanery of Shengay void by the Resignation of the said Andrew Pern at the Presentation of Granado Pigott of Bassingbourn in the said County Original Patron." The institution to Norton is certified by the bishop of Norwich in this form:—"Andrew Pern B.D. Instituted into the Rectory of Norton upon the Presentation of the Master or Keeper of Peterhouse College Cambridge and the Fellows or Scholars of the Bishop of Ely Patrons in full Right Jan^{ry} 24, 1742."

Barton of the parish of S. Andrew Holborn, London, clerk. He laid out on his Rectory-house here about £500, and resided alternately; one year at Abington, the other at Norton (near Bury St. Edmund's), in Suffolk. He married Mrs. Ann Dickman of Cambridge, and was brother to Chester Pern, Esq., of Little Abington. He died 23 Nov. 1772, aged 64, at Norton, and was buried there, as appears by the Parish Register.

1773, March 24. **Robert Hagar**, M.A., Fellow of Clare Hall, B.A. 1750, M.A. 1754. He was instituted at the presentation of Granado Pigott, Esq., and compounded for first fruits 27 March 1773, being bound himself with Granado Pigott of the parish of Saint George, Bloomsbury in the County of Middlesex, Esq. He was Vicar of Hawnes¹ (or Haynes) in Bedfordshire, and Chaplain to Robert, Earl Granville. Had dispensation to hold both livings in March 1773. He died at Hawnes, and was buried there 24 Oct. 1780; as appears by the Parish Register, wherein he is described as *Rector* (instead of Vicar), of that parish.

first fruits 2 April 1781, and again, for the same, 10 May 1782; his sureties on each occasion being Major Blundell and Thomas Strafford, or Stratford,¹ of Holborn in the City of London, haberdashers. Mr. Pern was also Rector of Isham Inferior in the county of Northampton and diocese of Peterborough; to which benefice he was instituted 17 Nov. 1781, at the presentation of the Bishop of Lincoln, in right of his see, and for the first fruits of which he compounded 8 April 1782, the aforesaid Thomas Strafford and Major Blundell being bound for him. He died 5 Dec. 1807, aged 55, and was buried in the chancel of Little Abington Church, where a tablet is inscribed to his memory.

1808, April 1. **William Adams**, D.D. Matriculated as son of John Adams, gent., from Pembroke College, Oxford, 20 May 1779, then aged 13. B.A. 1783, M.A. 1785, B.D. and D.D. 28 Jan. 1808. Vicar of Halstead, Essex, in 1804. Instituted to Abington at the presentation of the heirs of Granado Pigott, Esq. Died 29 March 1850, aged 86. See *Alumni Oxonienses* (ed. Foster).
