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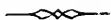
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# Preface.



THE Parish Registers of St. Mary the Virgin, Stoke D'Abernon, to 1812, are contained in three manuscript volumes.

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The Register Books are all in good condition, except for the mutilations referred to in the text on page 46.

The following chasms occur in Register I.:—

Burials, 1678—1690 . during the Rectorship of Francis Butterfield.  
Burials, 1691—1732 }  
Baptisms, 1721—1732 } during the Rectorship of Archdeacon  
Marriages, 1725—1732 } John Butterfield.

It is to be regretted that the Rectors, during the above period, were so remiss in their duties to the Parish.

A list of the Rectors from the late twelfth or early thirteenth century to the present date is included in a very able and lengthy article on Stoke D'Abernon Church, written by my friend Philip Mainwaring Johnston, F.S.A., F.R.I.B.A., and contributed to the Surrey Archæological Collections, vols. xx, xxi, xxii, and xxvi, and replete with illustrations.
