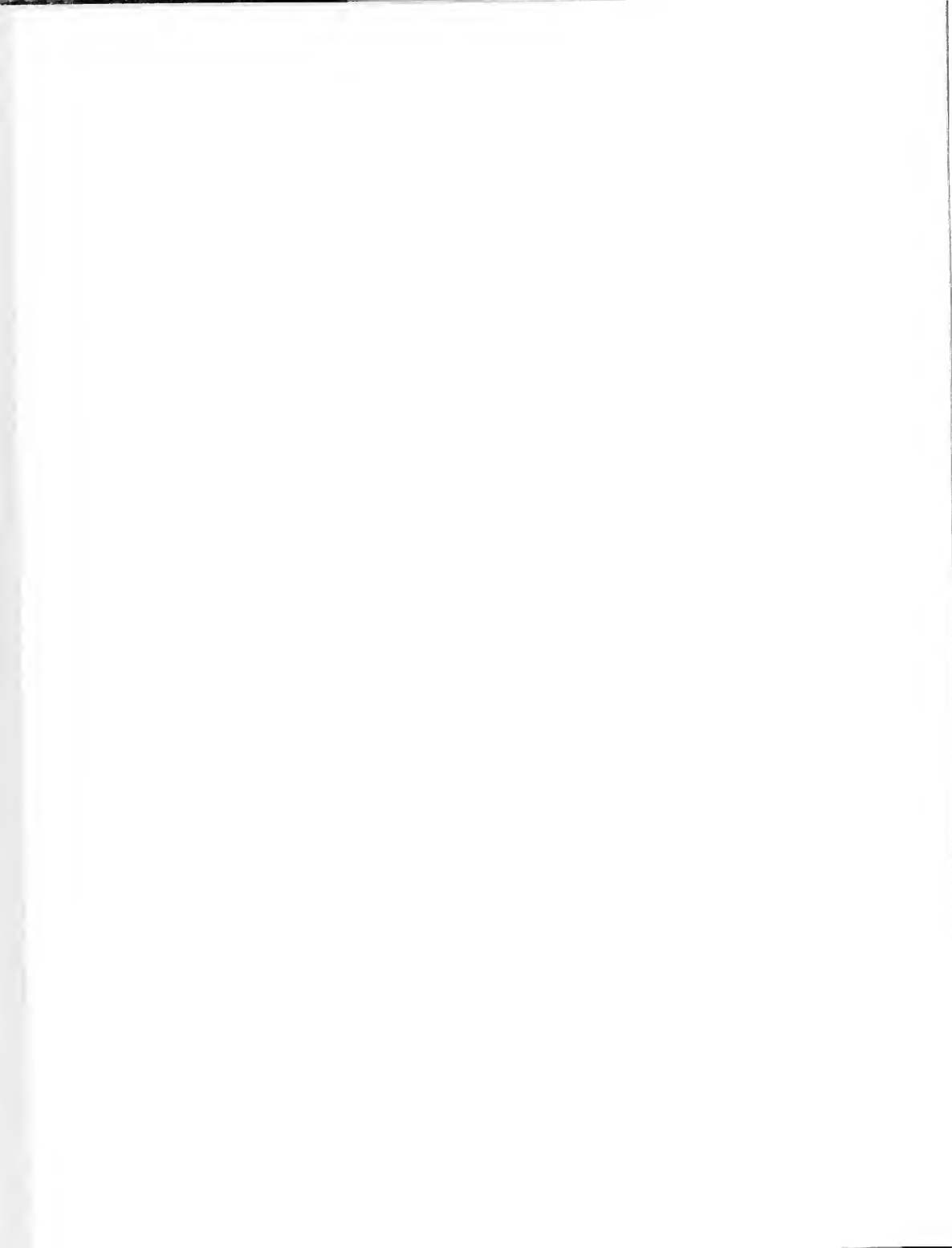

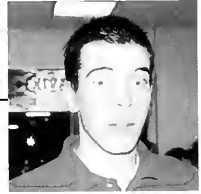

President's Address

To The Class of 2000

What an awesome title, *The Class of 2000*! You, as the graduating class of Tyndale College, are the first in the year 2000. Just the very idea triggers my imagination as to what significance this may have.

A Canadian prime minister, at the beginning of the 20th century, said that this was to be "Canada's century." During the last 100 years Canada did mark out its own territory of authority, establishing itself as a country other than an obedient child of the British Empire and the lackey of American cultural domination. We asserted our rights and responsibilities as a sovereign nation.

As we now move into not just a new century but a new millennium, there are four questions that hang on this milestone. What will become of the world? What will become of Canada? What will become of the church? What will become of your life? The first two are important and they matter to us as followers of Jesus. We do have something to say about what will become of the world and of Canada. The third question matters very much, for the church is not only "the bride" whom Jesus loves and died for, but it is the means through which we must address the first two questions.

Then I turn to you, students and graduates of Tyndale College. What will become of you?


As I live within the last decade of my ministry, I reflect on the critical decisions I've made in life. Some have been wise and good, and others (more than I would like to admit) have been not so wise. But I have known this: my life is in the hands of a good and loving God. As living/being "in his image", my life matters greatly to Him. I'm not spun out with a "sink or swim" vulnerability. The opposite is true. As I continue - even through my failures and self-inflicted miscues - to trust God to lead, I can be assured that at all times, in all places I am surrounded by His Spirit and ministering servants. And so each of you, as you trust the Lord to lead in your life, can be assured the you are and will be surrounded in the same way.

Added to that promise is His vested concern in whom we become. Though life now seems endless, you too will come to the end of life as we know it. That too is just the beginning. What you do in this life has continuity and consequence forever. That's why your life during the new millennium is of such great importance. Character and integrity are everything. Out of that comes the well-being of your developed gifts; out of that emerges the life-giving stuff of God's goodness; out of that flows the contribution you can and should make to God's creation.

In one sense the year 2000 is just another blip on the radar screen of history, marking out the passing of another 365 days. In another sense it tells us in a dramatic way that there will be an end to history: it is not eternally cyclical, lasting forever. We are promised an end to this form of creation, into a timelessness in which Christ will rule over all. That is the most dynamic of our hopes, for today has meaning within the larger and longer realities of space and time.

Thus to be part of *The Class of 2000* is historic. It is your opportunity to set a new level of achievement, a new standard of scholarship, a new expression of spiritual commitment and a new measurement of servanthood.

I congratulate you, *Class of 2000!*
