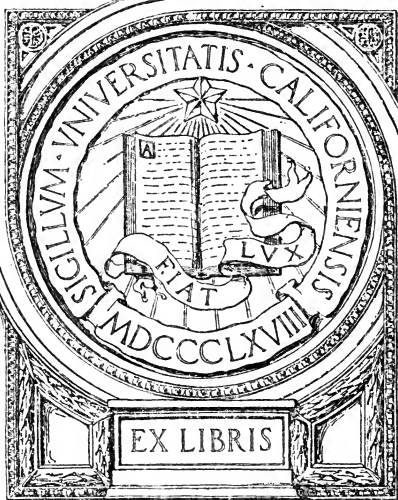

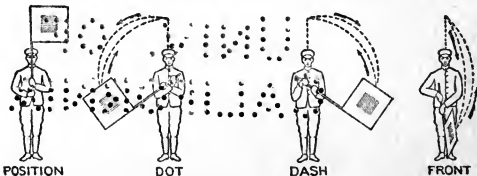

























End of a word, - - - front	Repeat last word, - CC front front
End of a sentence, - - front front	Repeat last message, { CCC front front front
End of a message, - - { front front	Move a little to right, RR front
Signature follows, - - sig. front	Move a little to left, LL front
Error, - - - - - AA front	Move a little up hill, UU front
Acknowledgment (or)	Move a little down hill, DD front
I understand, - - - MM front	Signal faster, - - - FF front
Cease signaling, - - - MMM front	Wait a moment, - - · · · · · front
Repeat after (word) - { CC front A front (word)	To break or stop signals, BK

The position is with the flag or other appliance held vertically, the signalman directly facing station with which it is desired to communicate. The "dot" is to the right of sender, embracing an arc of 90°, starting with the vertical and returning to it. The "dash" is a similar motion to left. "Front" is downward directly in front and instantly returned to vertical; it indicates a pause or conclusion.
