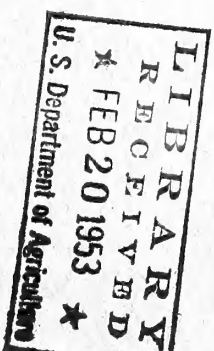

(Account drought, we are short on Dixie 18 in flat grains, but have been successful in getting some good certified rounds. You may order rounds without flats, but if you want 5 bu of flats or more, please also order an equal number of bu of rounds. This is being done to try to divide our limited supply around. Even rounds are scarce. Rounds are cheaper than flats. They will produce the same kind of corn and as much as flats.
