"for the benefit of Fugitive Slaves who may escape from the slaveholding States of this infamous Union, from time to time".

Art. 6. To Wendell Phillips, Lucy Stone,
and Susan B. Anthony (& 2 others to be
added if they deem it expedient) \$5000.

for Women's Rights to vote, hold office, manage
& derive property, & all other Rights enjoyed by Men.
(Already paid)

Art. 7. To F. J. Meriam — \$100.

" 8. Has already given his children \$8000.
each [his father gave him \$5000.]

Leaves one third part of the residue of
his Estates to Edmund Jackson in
trust for Eliza F. Eddy. At her decease,

half of the income to the Trustees named
in 6th article; the other half of income
to Pizzie F. Bacon during her natural life.
At her decease, ^{& decease of both} the whole, principal &
interest to the Trustees named in 6th article.

Art. 9. Another ~~third~~ third part to Edmund
Jackson, in trust for James Jackson, who
is to have whole income during his life. At his
decease, one half of income to Trustees named
in 4th article, & one half of income to his children (if
any; at their decease (or at his if no children), the
whole Fund to be paid to Trustees in 4th article.

Art. 10. Another third part to George Jackson,
in trust for his daughter Harriette M. Palmer,
she to have entire income during her life;
at her decease, one half of income to Trustees
named in 4th article; the other half of income
in equal proportions to her children; at
their decease, the whole of said Fund to
the Trustees named in 4th article. If she
leave no children, the whole fund to be paid
at her death, to said Trustees.

Art. 11 No bonds of any of the Trustees,

Art. 12. Edmund Jackson, Sole Executor,
do bonds to be required of him.
Gives him \$1000. for the service.
Authorizes him to sell any all the
Real Estate.
