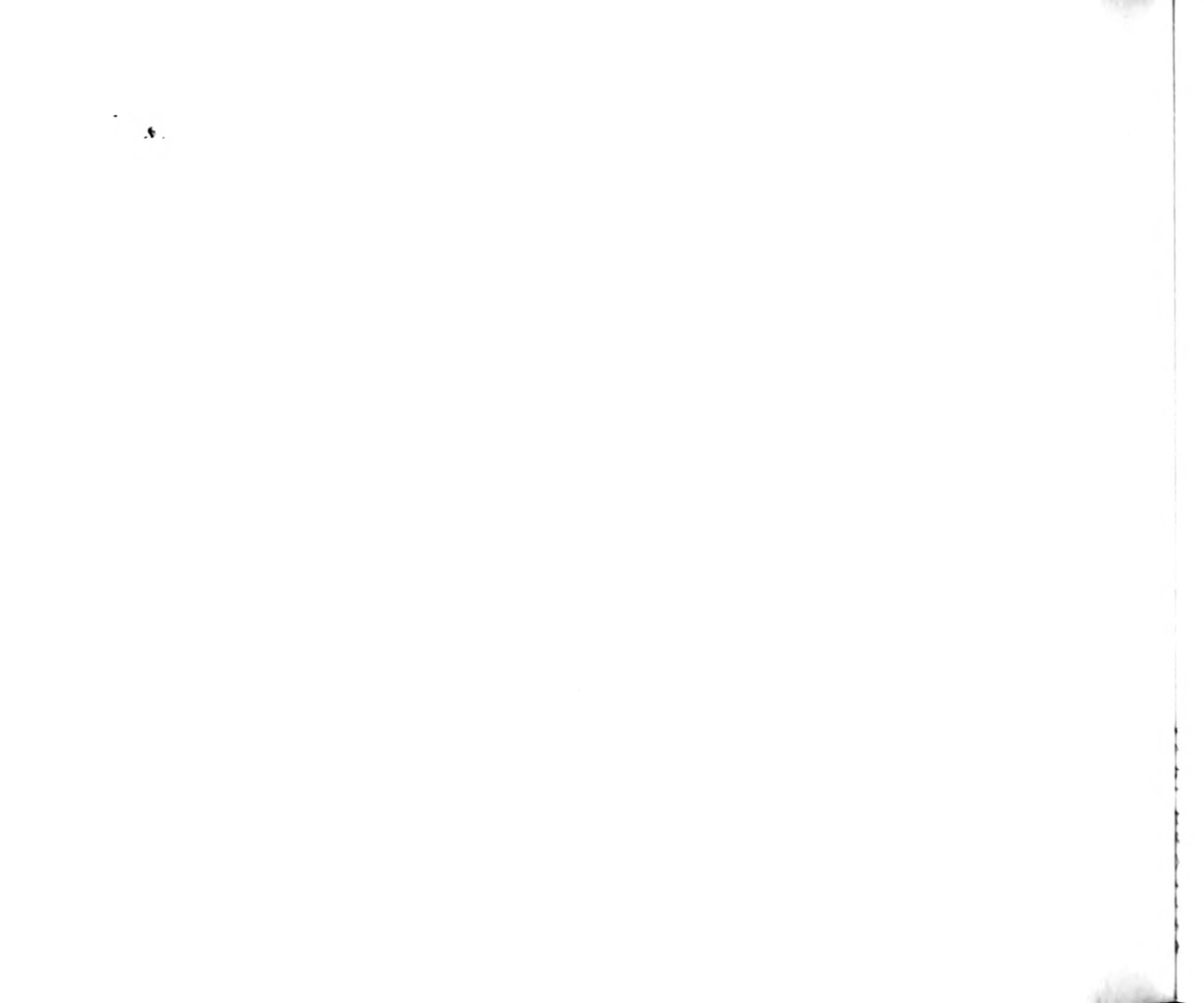

RECORD OF THE WOOD FAMILY

David Wood moved from Plymouth, Mass., in 1792 and settled on a place which was afterward the homestead of his son, Luther B. Wood. There were three sons of whom we know—Calvin, Luther B. and Timothy.

His son Martin B. Wood enlisted in the civil war August 16, 1862, Company B, 2nd regiment. He was killed at Spottsylvania, Va., May 12, 1864. Another son, Henry C., enlisted May 9, 1861, in the same regiment. David Wood served in the War of the Revolution. Two of his sons served in the war of 1812.

We have been informed that David Wood was of Scotch descent. His wife's maiden name was Cooley. Calvin Wood was not married.
