EXPO 67 SHAPES

MONTREAL, Canada (UPI)—A group of 100,000 people a party is taking shape on the banks of the St. Lawrence River islands and a peninsula in the city of Montreal.

They call it Expo 67, the Montreal 67 centennial celebration. It represents the closing of the 60th year of mankind's first universities.

New State University In Boston?

A bill has been filed that would create a new university in Greater Boston with \$100 million bond issue. It is headed by O'Leary (D-South Boston - 1st District) and says that the current University of Massachusetts branch, Boston State College and Massachusetts College of Art be combined into a new University at Boston, and be located on an undeveloped 100-acre site behind the Chestnut Hill shopping center.

O'Leary said he would like to consider the opportunity of getting the opportunity to create a higher education. He is critical of the program of the new Boston branch of the University of Massachusetts.

Theoretically, the purposes of O'Leary's proposal would be served by the current UMass-Boston operation in the long run. But O'Leary wants Boston State College merged into the proposed new school with a separate board of seven trustees.

O'Leary's plan is in opposition to the Williams-Harrington Report on education which would use a single university in the public higher education system. But O'Leary claims he has strong support from Boston legislators.

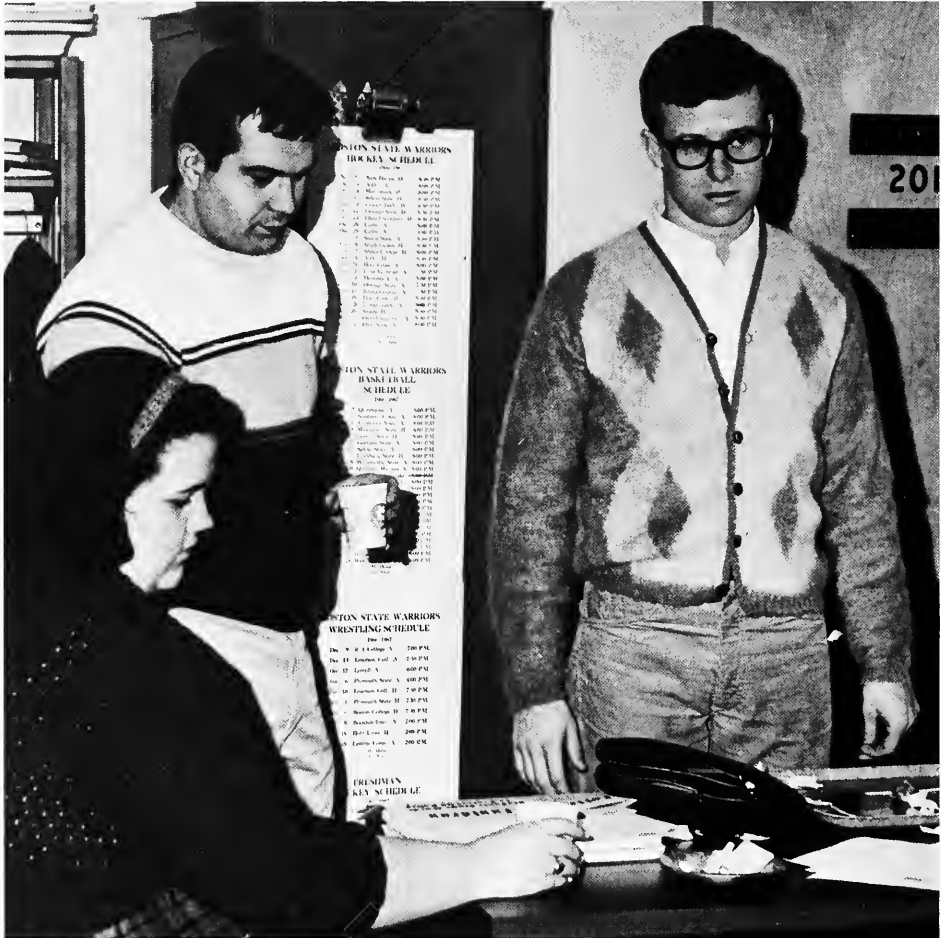
Would the Office of the Governor be able to give the students at the State College at Boston any information when and if the Fatina Corporation will honor its contract with the Commonwealth?
