## PESTICIDES PUBLICATIONS LIST

This list contains only current, up-to-date State publications on pesticide use and safety. These were submitted by the States in response to a recent questionnaire.

The publications have been classified by intended audiences. Primary audience is designated by a large X; secondary audience, if any, is represented by a small x. Copies of those not marked were not available for examination.

The audience classifications include:

Commercial Farmer - Those publications dealing specifically with crop production, livestock production, etc. on the commercial farm; technical bulletins (primarily aimed at subject matter specialists) regarding the control of a specific disease or insect on a crop or type of livestock which the producers will ultimately use as a source of information.

Non-farm User - All publications dealing with use of pesticides around the home, garden, lawn, household pests, mosquitoes, etc.; use of pesticides on small areas of crop production and shrubs, ornamentals, flowers, etc.

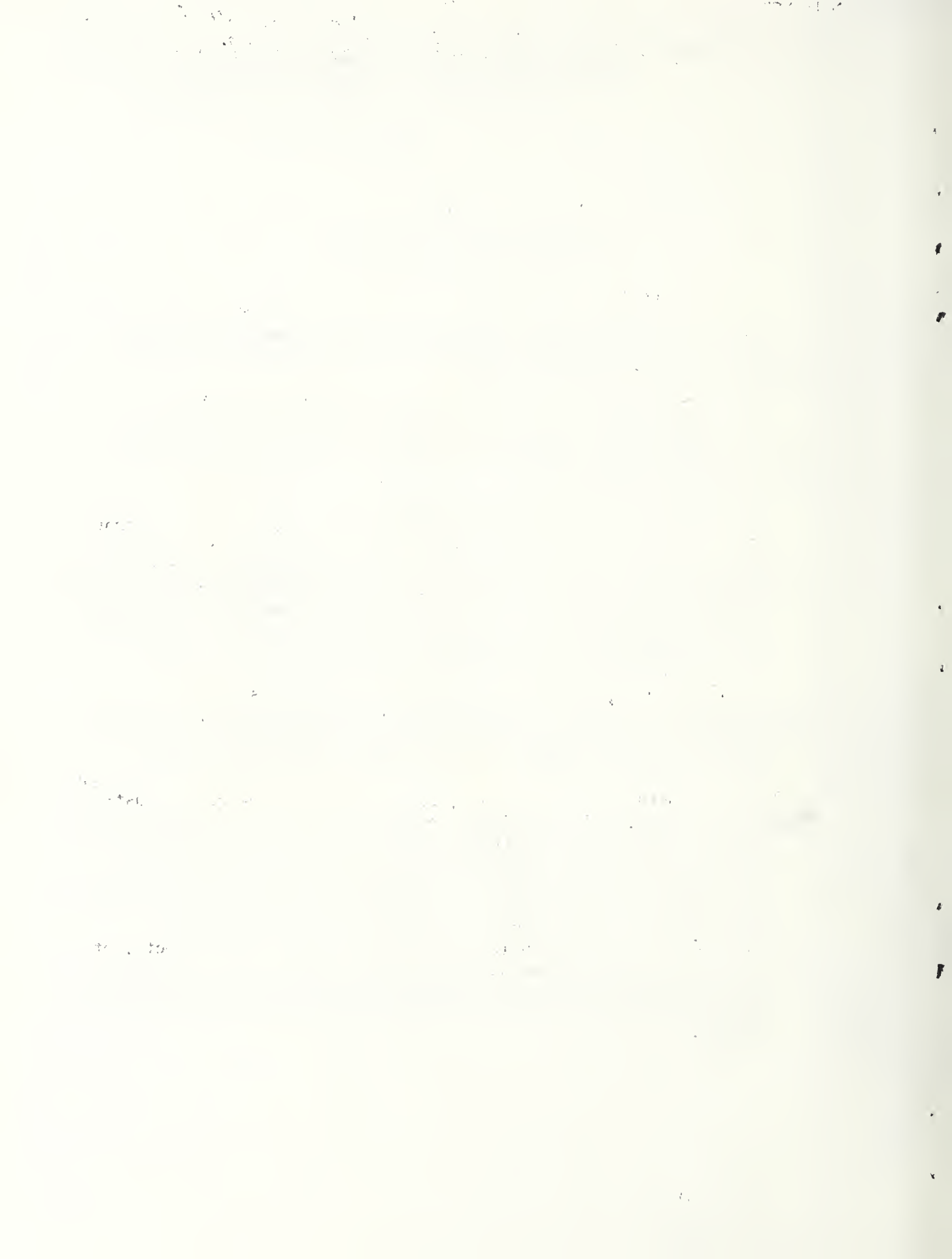
Dealers (or technical information) - Those publications directed at the dealer or handler of pesticides, commercial lawn sprayer, industry representative, and/or municipal officials, (usually associated with mosquito control or weed and insect control in park or recreation areas); those materials that county agents, home advisors, or specialists may use in part to inform the public or farmer.

General Public - Publications associated with public affairs or those informing the general public of the hazards, benefits, effects, etc. of using pesticides; 4-H and FFA materials associated with pesticide use.
