GENERAL INFORMATION

Please Note

This sale will be held on Wednesday, October 5th. On the following day, Thursday, October 6th, the annual Fall Show and Sale of the Illinois Polled Shorthorn Breeders' Association will be held at Normal, Illinois. 16 bulls and 31 females will be held at Normal and they have been carefully selected from the top herds in the strongest Polled Shorthorn state. These two sales are exactly 100 miles apart. We will arrange auto transportation for all who do not have cars. We will also cooperate in assembling cattle purchased in the two sales.

Sale Location—This sale will be held at Carona Farm No. 1, owned by Carl M. Johnson, DeKalb, Illinois. This farm is located on Illinois Highway 23, two miles south of DeKalb and eight miles north of the junction of U.S. 30 and Illinois 23.

Time—The sale will be held on Wednesday, October 5, 1955, starting promptly at 12:30 p.m. Central Standard Time. Lunch will be served at the farm.

Transportation—DeKalb is on the main line of the Chicago and Northwestern Railway running from Chicago to Omaha. Frequent trains from Chicago, distance of 58 miles. There is an approved airport at DeKalb for those who fly their own planes.

Hotel Accommodations—We recommend the Baker Hotel in St. Charles, Illinois, and the Fargo Hotel in Sycamore. There are numerous comfortable motels within easy driving distance. 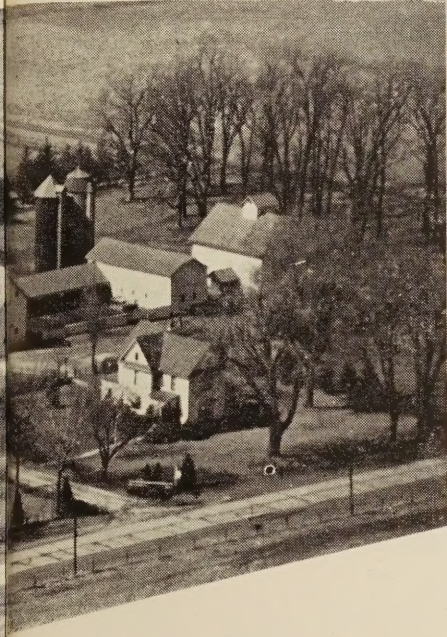

Carona Farms, where the production of 560 rich Illinois acres is marketed entirely through livestock, is an institution of which all Polled Shorthorn breeders may be proud. 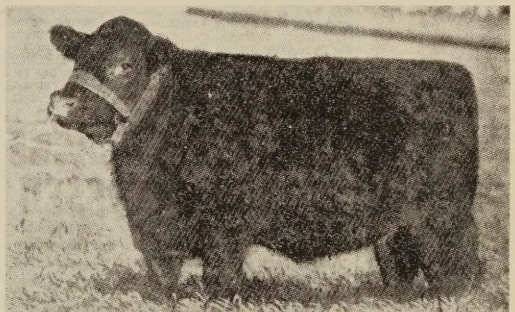

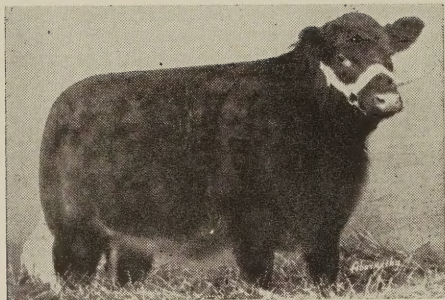
Terms and Conditions

Terms—The terms of this sale are cash. Settlements are to be made with the clerk of the sale immediately at the conclusion of the auction. All stock will be at buyer's risk as soon as bid off but the management will assist in loading on cars or trucks in compliance with instructions from purchasers.

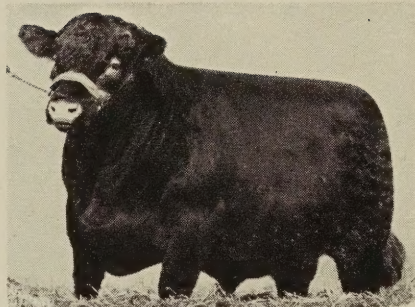
Guarantee—All cattle in this sale will be sold under the standard guarantee endorsed by the American Shorthorn Breeders' Association. Certificates of registry and transfer will be furnished with each lot sold. Shipment will be made as soon as possible after the close of the sale without trouble to the purchasers, but cattle will be at buyer's risk as soon as bid off. Every precaution will be taken to see that animals arrive in sound and healthy condition.

Health—The Carona Herd has been Federally Accredited for T.B. since 1923. All cattle in this sale have been tested for Tuberculosis and Bang's Disease within 30 days of the date of the sale. Health certificates will be supplied. All of the females in the sale have been calfhood vaccinated for Bang's.

Liability—Each transaction in this sale will constitute a contract between the buyer and the seller of each lot. The auctioneer, clerk and sale manager have been employed by Carl M. Johnson and Glen L. Anderson for specific tasks not connected with the handling of the cattle or the condition of the premises, and they accept no liability for the contract or for any accidents that may occur. Carl M. Johnson and Glen L. Anderson will make every effort to provide for the comfort and safety of those attending the sale, but neither can accept liability for injuries that may occur. Accidents at cattle sales are rare, but all attending must do so at their own risk. Footnotes were written by the owners or from information provided by them.

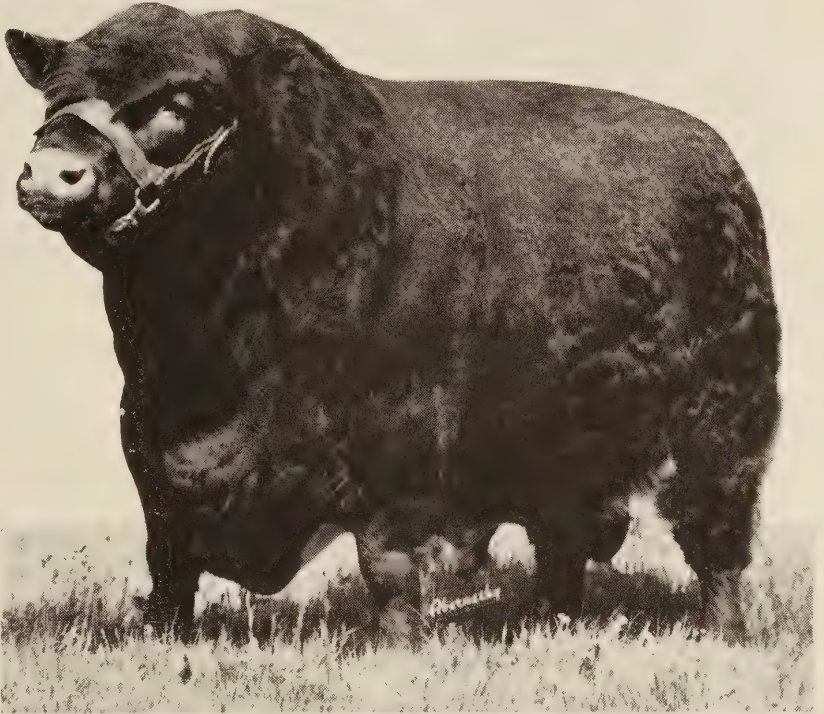

Highlights in the life of . . .

CHERRY HILL ROYAL OAK x2345276

Purchased at \$3,800 in the 1947 Cherry Hill Sale. Within thirty days following purchase he was awarded the reserve grand championship in strong horned competition at the Eastern National Exposition and reserve grand championship at the International Live Stock Show.

His first five calves brought back more than the purchase price and those that were sold from the first two calf crops averaged well into four figures.

His third calf crop produced Carona Fascination x. He was sold at the side of his dam, Carona Belle 9th x, in the March, 1951, Illinois State Sale, where she won the female grand championship and he won the bull grand championship at 7 months old.

At the 1952 International, Carona Fascination x won the reserve grand championship for Lynwood Farms and Carona Direct x won the reserve junior championship for Carl M. Johnson. Both are sons of Cherry Hill Royal Oak x.

In the 1953 International Sale his son, Carona Masterpiece x, was purchased by Dalgety & Co. of Australia at \$1,600. This bull was later resold in Australia for 2,500 guineas (\$7,500). The top selling female in the same sale was out of a daughter of Cherry Hill Royal Oak x.

At the 1954 International, the great

young bull LF Fascination x owned by Landen Farms, was awarded the grand championship. He is a son of Carona Fascination x by Cherry Hill Royal Oak x.

At the 1955 Illinois State Fair, Carona Bard x, a son of Cherry Hill Royal Oak x, won first prize in the senior yearling class as well as senior and reserve grand championship. He was named grand champion in the Illinois Division.

At the same show, Carona Clarion x, selling as Lot 1 in this sale was first prize senior bull calf and reserve junior champion in the open show. He was named reserve grand champion in the Illinois Division.

Also at the same show sons of Cherry Hill Royal Oak won first prize in the 2-bull class, second prize in the 3-bull class, and daughters of this great sire won grand championship and reserve junior championship in the Illinois division.

During the past five years, sons and daughters of Cherry Hill Royal Oak x have won nine championships and four reserve championships at Illinois State Shows and Sales held under the auspices of the Illinois Shorthorn Breeders' Association.

Ten sons of Carona Fascination x are selling in the Lynnwood All-Bull Sale at Carmel, Indiana, on November 5th, and they are among the tops in that sale.



CARONA DIRECT X

First prize junior yearling and reserve junior champion at the 1952 International Live Stock show. This son of the noted Cherry Hill Royal Oak x was bred and exhibited by Carl M. Johnson and is now owned in partnership by Glen L. Anderson and Carl M. Johnson. The first calves by Carona Direct arrived in April of this year and there are now 26 of them. They are exactly the kind that might be expected from a bull of his kind. His service will be a feature of this sale.

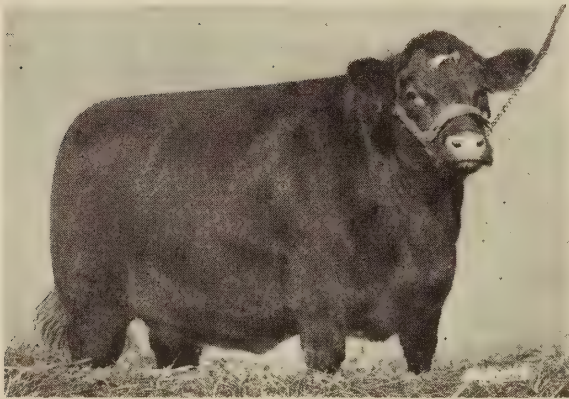

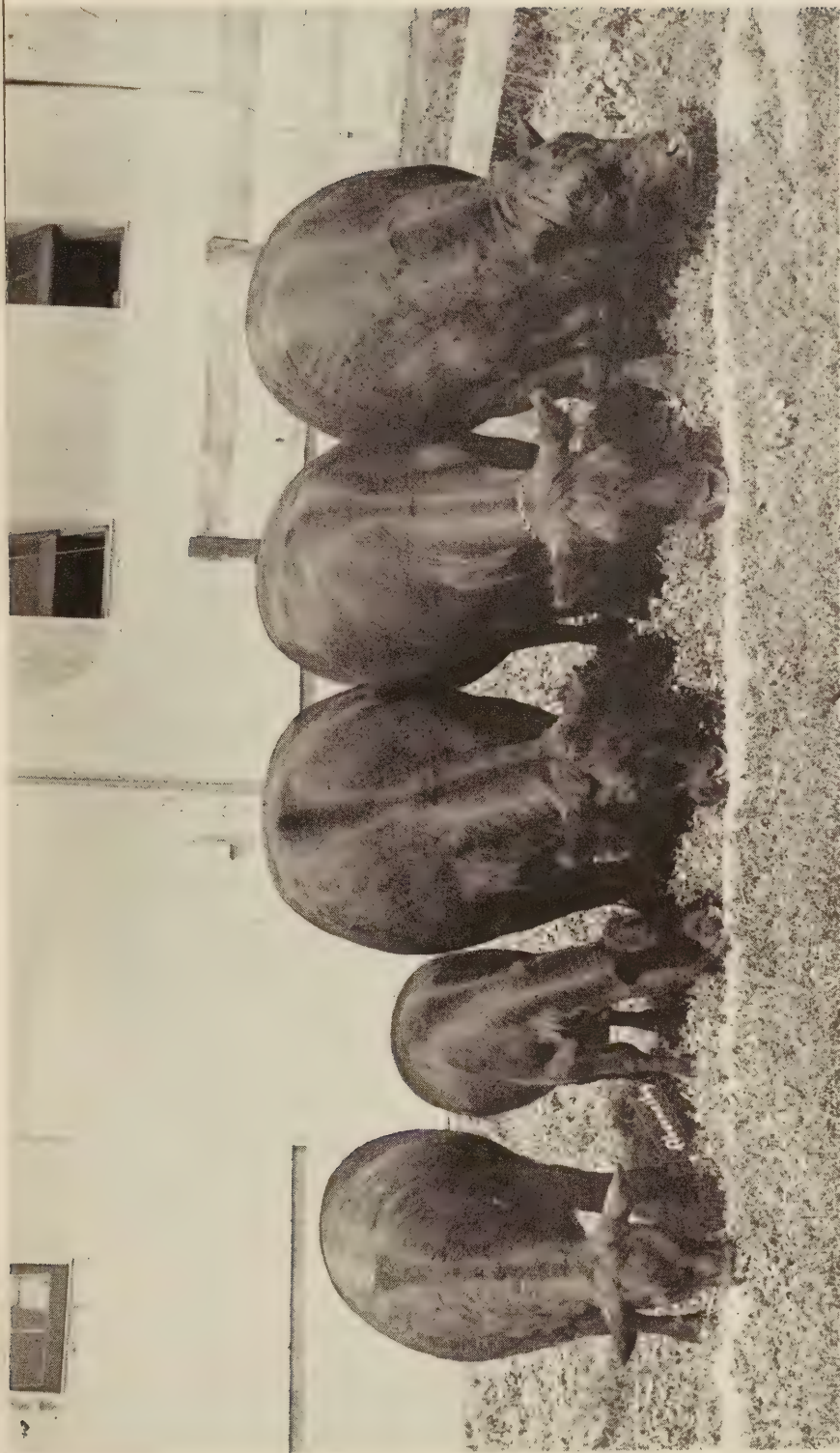

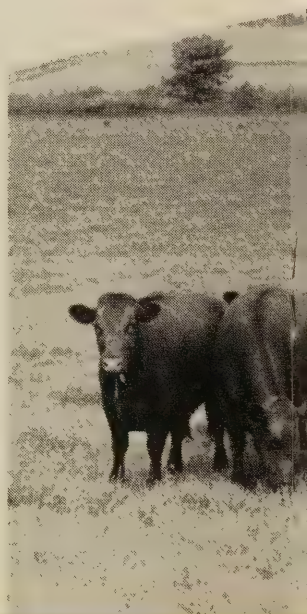
