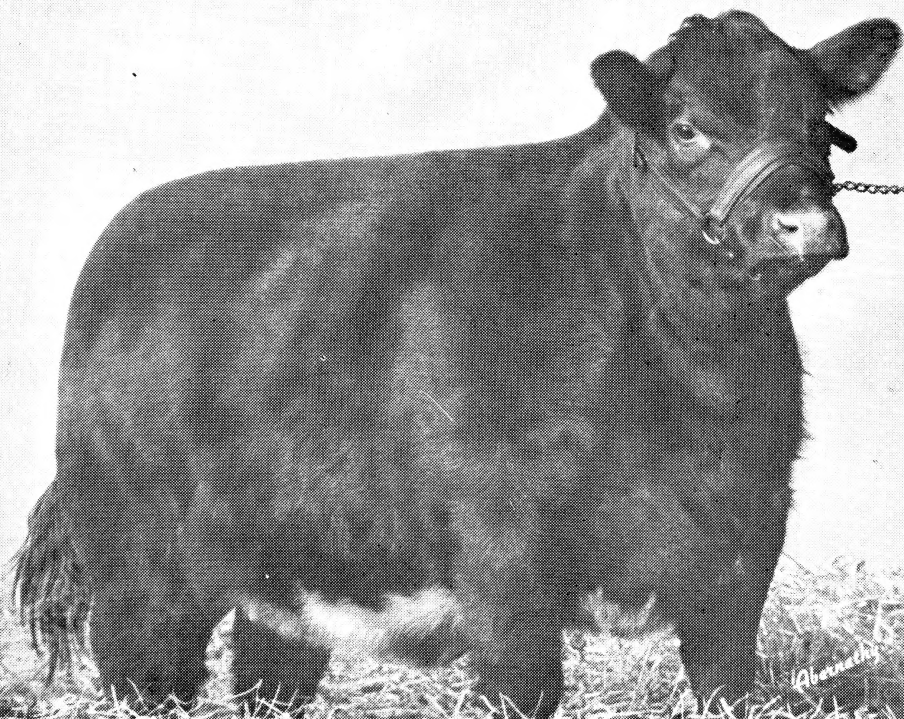

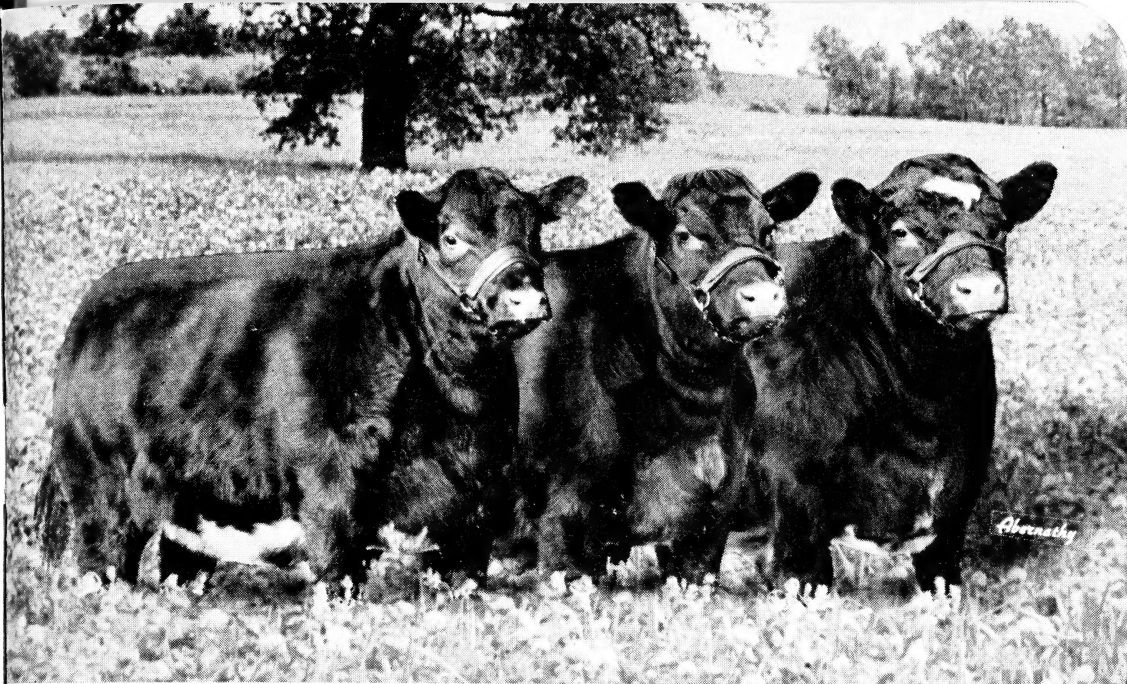

We have honored the heifer Edith Souchong x by placing her picture on the front cover of this catalog. She was bred at Hi Ho Farm and was purchased in the 1956 "Stars of the East" Sale by George Arrowsmith, Upperco, Baltimore County, Maryland. At \$5,600, this daughter of Edellyn Yankee Mercury is the all-time record selling female of the Polled Shorthorn breed in North America. Many experts have described her as one of the finest polled heifers ever produced.



Success in the field of improved livestock comes only to those breeders who have a type in mind and who constantly strive toward this type. This picture shows three animals produced on the farm where this sale is to be held. This is the type that will be found throughout this sale. The trio, sired by Edellyn Yankee Mercury, won second prize in the junior get-of-sire class at the 1955 International Live Stock Show. 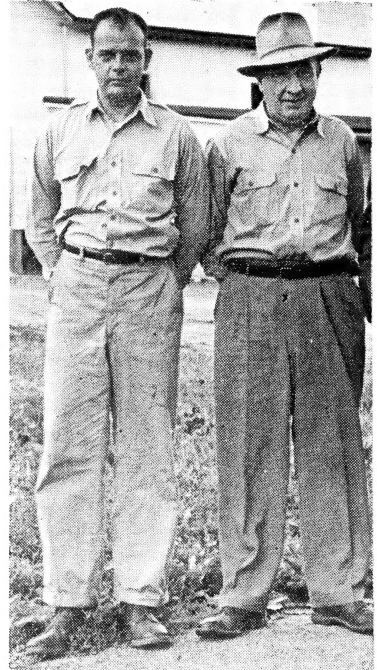

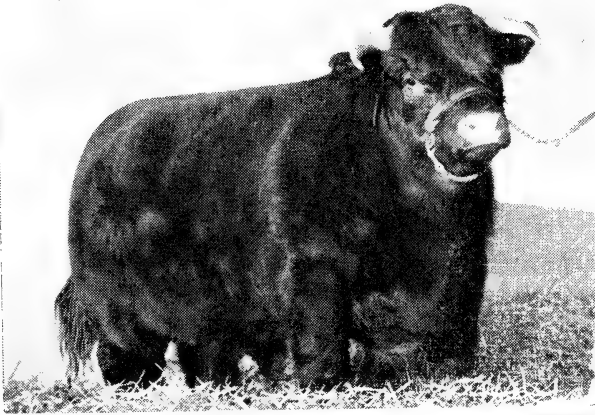

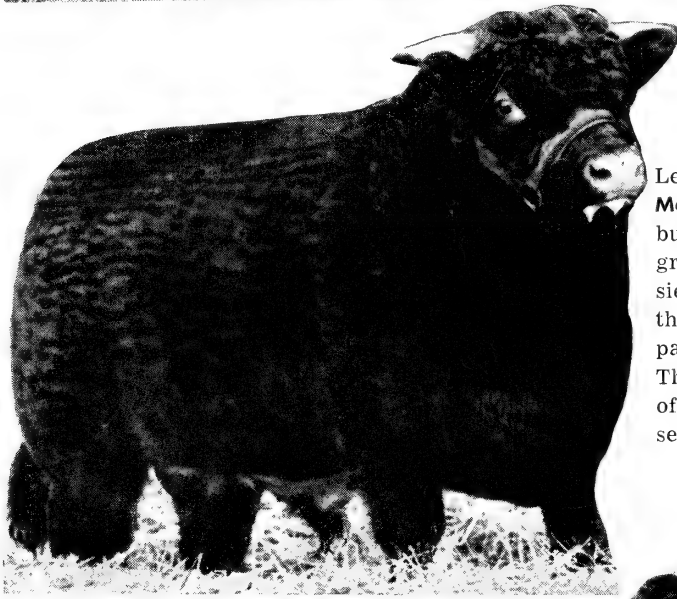

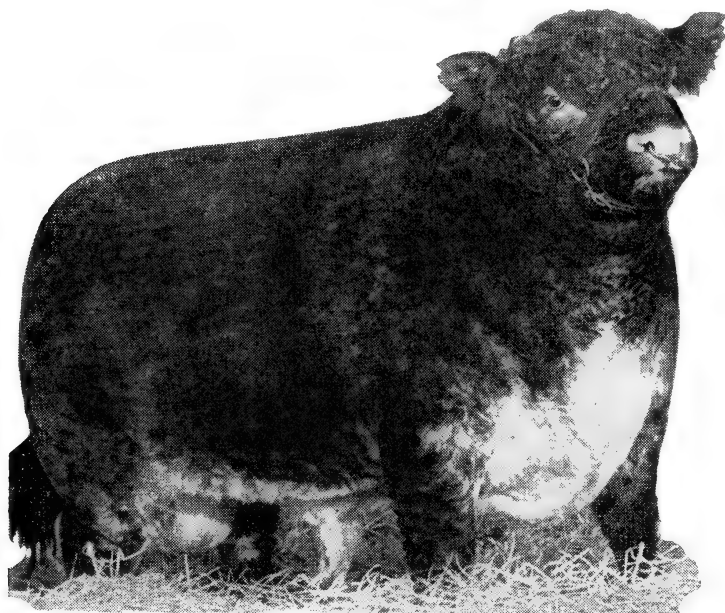

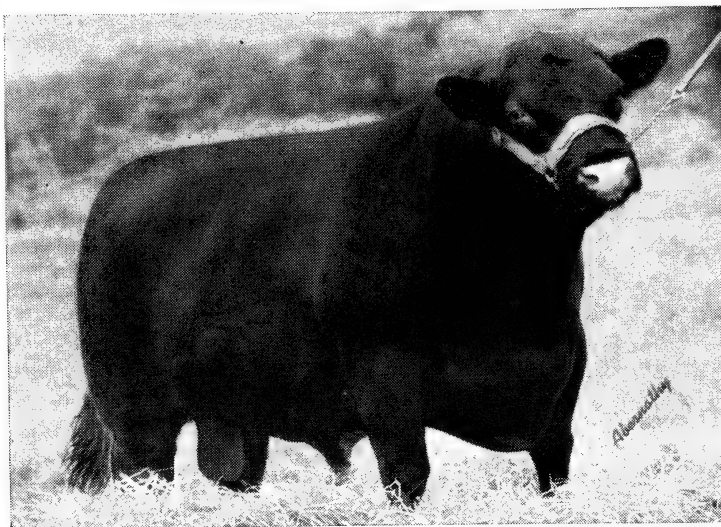

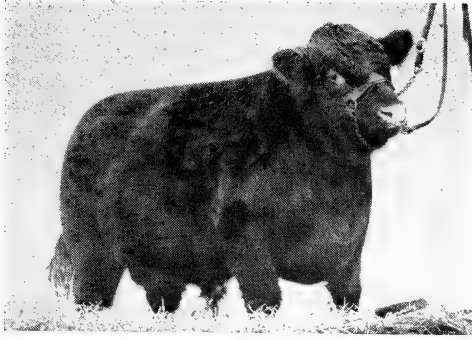

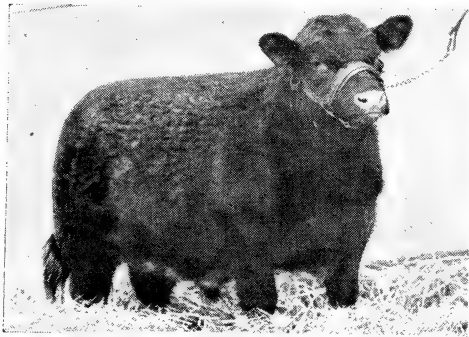
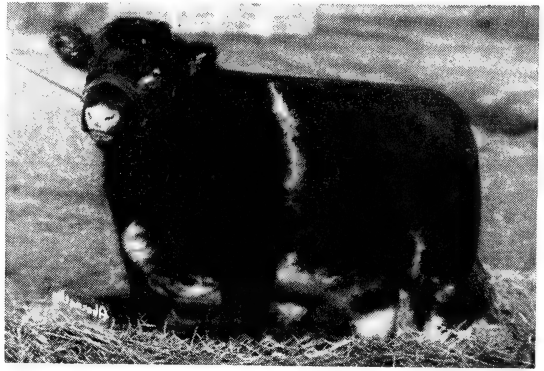

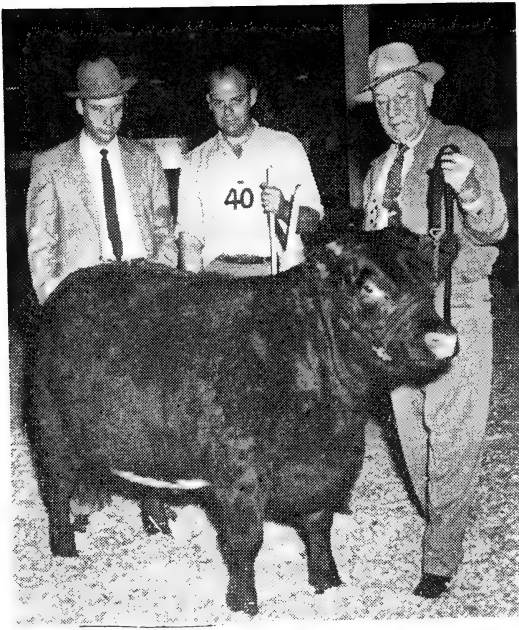

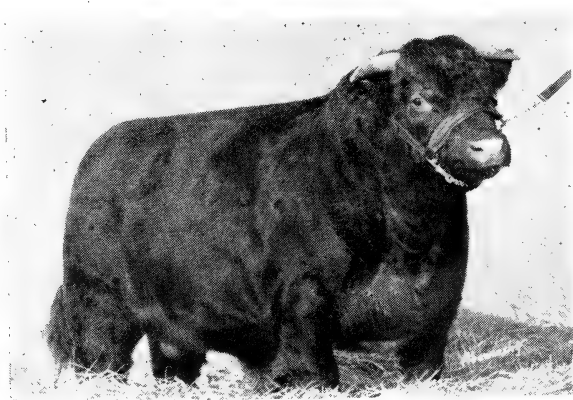

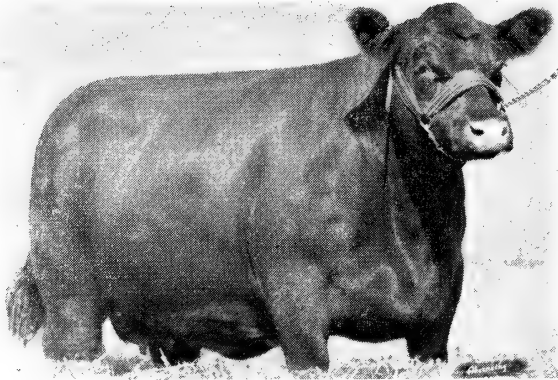

1. Proper care must be given by purchaser to protect breeding qualities and health of guaranteed animals.
2. All bulls are guaranteed breeders, provided they are not allowed to serve when under 14 months of age, or allowed to run with the herd when under 20 months of age. In case of failure of a bull to be a breeder, notice shall be given to the seller within six months of date of purchase, or by the time the bull is 20 months of age, if purchased under 14 months of age.
3. With the exception of heifers sold under 14 months of age, all females are guaranteed breeders. Heifers under two years of age shall not be served by a heavy or old bull. Cows or heifers sold as bred, or safe in calf, not proving to be in calf must be reported to the seller within three months after date of sale. Females over 14 months of age sold open, not settling within six months after date of sale, shall be promptly reported to the seller.

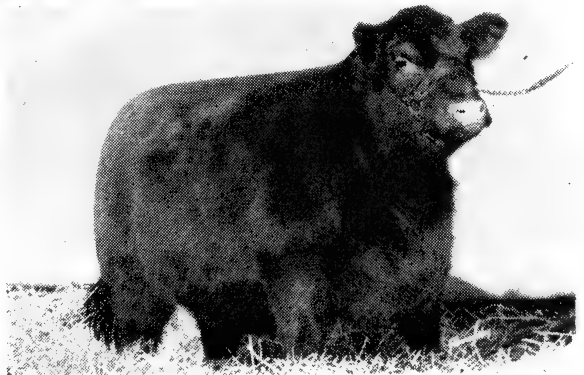

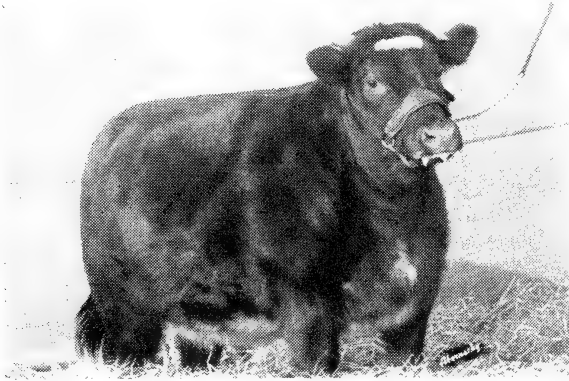

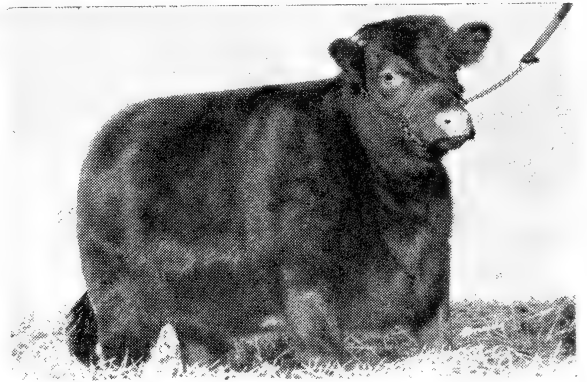

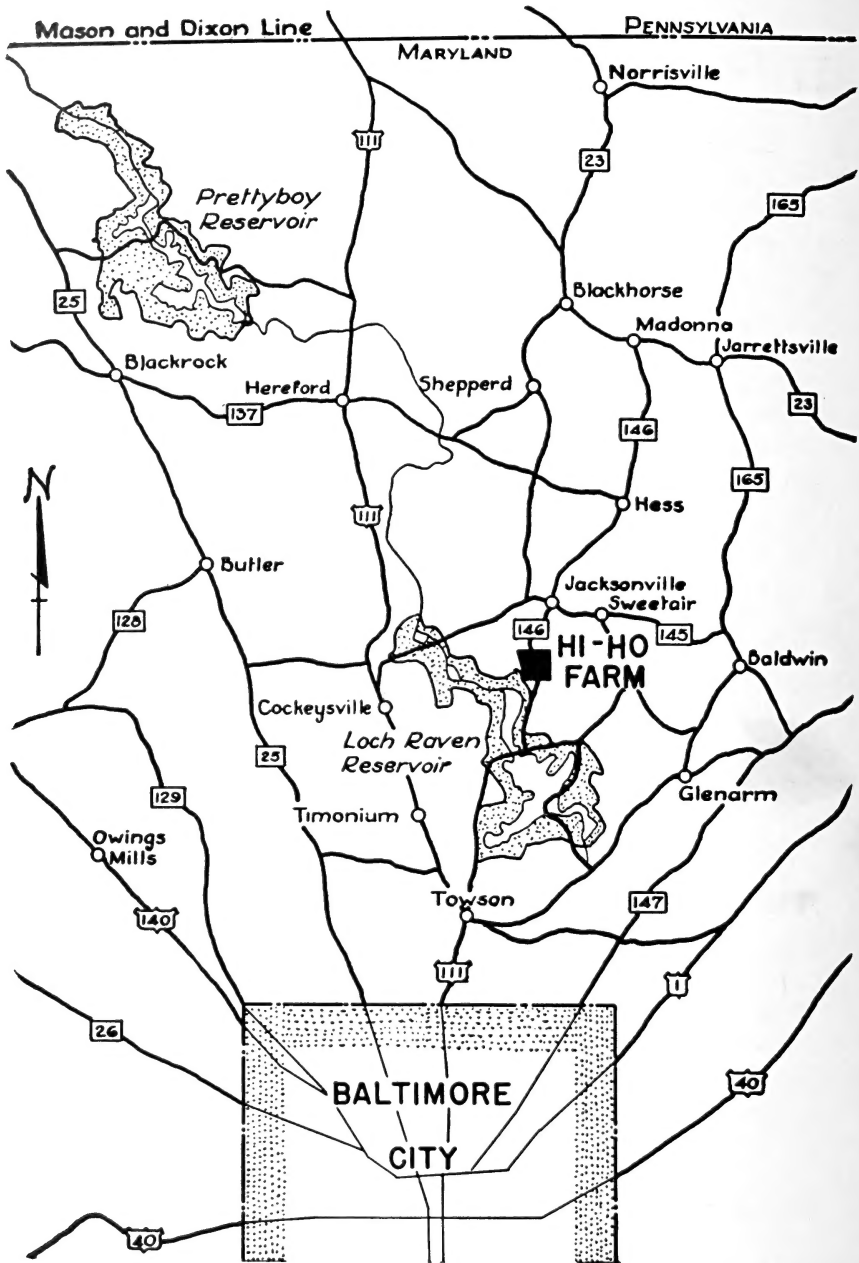
