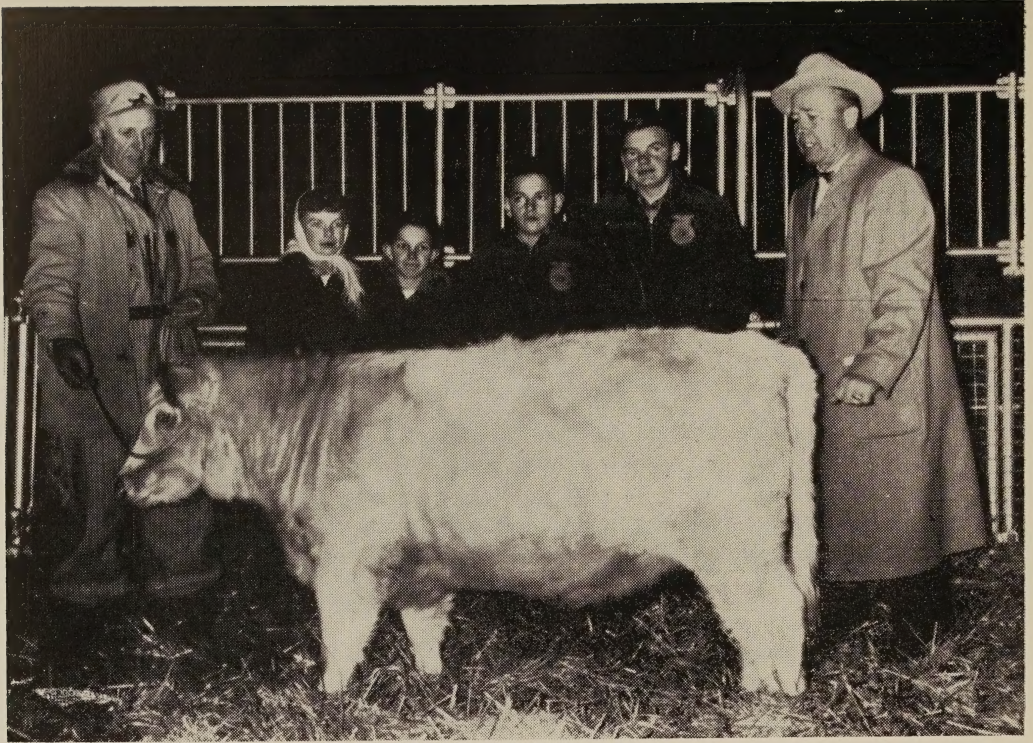

**STANDARD GUARANTEE OF AMERICAN SHORTHORN BREEDERS
ASSOCIATION**



1. Proper care must be given by purchaser to protect breeding qualities and health of guaranteed animals.

2. All bulls are guaranteed breeders provided they are not allowed to serve when under 14 months of age, or allowed to run with the herd when under 20 months of age. In case of failure of a bull to be a breeder, notice shall be given to the seller within six months of date of purchase, or by the time the bull is 20 months of age, if purchased under 14 months of age.

3. With the exception of heifers sold under 14 months of age, all females are guaranteed breeders. Heifers under two years of age shall not be served by a heavy or old bull. Cows or heifers sold as bred, or safe in calf, not proving to be in calf must be reported to the seller within three months after date of sale. Females over 14 months of age sold open, not settling within six months after date of sale, shall be promptly reported to the seller.

4. When an animal fails to comply with the above guarantee the seller has the option of substituting an animal of equal value to the satisfaction of the purchaser, or of having the animal returned for a trial for a period not to exceed six months. The expense of freight in such case is to be paid by the seller. If the animal is then proven to be a breeder beyond doubt it shall be returned to the purchaser at his expense. In case of dispute the return of the full purchase price, without interest, to the buyer will be considered full settlement and satisfaction to all claims. No charge for feed or maintenance shall be made by either buyer or seller. Salvage shall go to the seller. It shall be understood that the same guarantee given for the first animal shall likewise apply to any other animal later substituted.

5. All animals are sold to comply with the laws regulating Tuberculosis and Bangs Disease of the state or country into which they may be shipped.

6. Certificates of registry and transfer will be furnished with each animal sold. A signed pedigree application for unborn calves shall be furnished with bred females, showing names and record numbers of sire and dam, as well as service date.

7. Shipment shall be made as soon as possible after the close of the sale, but at purchaser's risk of loss or injury after animal is bid off. Where cattle are sold at private treaty the above terms should apply as well as for sale at auction.
