Up to this time the Jersey Wakefield has been cultivated for the earliest of all Cabbage, producing pointed or so-called sugar-loaf heads, but in the 20 th Century we have the round shape, like All Seasons and others, which is the most preferable form of head. A novel feature of this variety is in its forming a number of small cabbage, similar to Brussels Sprouts (and equally as good) at base of cabbage or top of stem.

The heads of the 20th Century Cabbage are round and solid
as a cannon-ball and earlier than any other sort. It grows more compactly, thus yielding a much larger crop than either Wakefield or Winnigstadt. For garden or market use it is unexcelled.
