Kansas City, Fort Scott & Memphis Railway, Kansas City & Pacific Railroad, and all their branches and connections. Also by Adams and American Express Companies.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS.

Terms of Payment.—Cash or satisfactory security before shipment of Stock. All orders to be sent by Express, C. O. D., must be accompanied by one-half the amount in cash.

CONDITION OF SALE.—1. When stock is to be boxed or bailed we charge for cost of labor and material.

- 2. We deliver all Goods Free of Drayage to Railroad or Express Offices after which our responsibility ceases.
- 3. At these prices selection of varieties must be left to us, but we always give purchaser his choice, so far as consistent with our stock, 50 at 100 rates and 500 at 1000 rates. \$50.00 worth or more at 1000 rates regardless of number taken.

GRADES.

For instance, in a grade of four to five feet, four feet trees are included, but five feet trees go into the next grade higher and likewise where calipered. If plump five feet trees are wanted, the order must be for five to six feet.
