VLADIMIR, Sour—A native of North Central Russia; black, medium to large; perfectly hardy and free from Black knot. A prolific bearer; an "iron-clad."

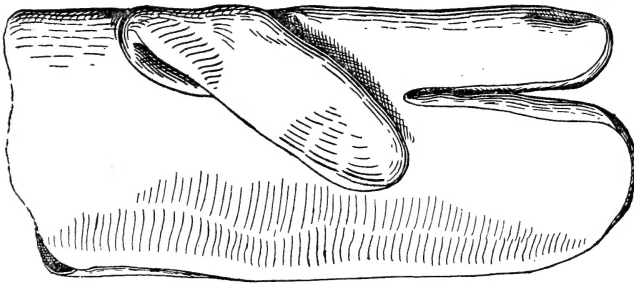
