

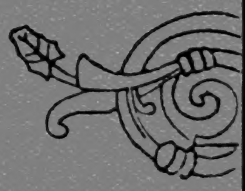

Season 1902

We take pleasure in submitting herewith our **Wholesale Trade Prices** for 1902, and trust they will be found as low as like quality of seeds are being sold. We handle nothing that has not been most carefully grown from **Choicest Stock Seed**, and which is suited for the most critical trade.

Crops and Prices

There is a very limited supply, the present season, in many varieties of garden seeds, caused by unprecedented failures of crops over the seed producing sections of Europe and America. We hope to have enough, in most varieties, to supply our customers, but owing to scarcity and the difficulty to procure reliable stocks, the within quotations are only good for early orders, or so long as our present holdings are unsold, nor can we hold ourselves liable for quantity, where failure of crops has reduced anticipated supplies. Prices are subject to change without notice.

Shipment and Packing

Our prices are for delivery ex-warehouse Toronto. All orders will be carefully prepared for shipment. Bags and cases necessary for packing and transportation will be charged at value. They are not returnable, nor will they be allowed for. They must be considered a necessary part of the purchase.

Mailing Seeds

Seeds will be sent by mail when requested or when the cost for carriage by mail is less than by other transportation. When sent by mail **five cents per pound** will be charged for the prepayment of postage and the necessary extra cost for packing.

Terms

All seeds herein quoted (unless otherwise noted), are due and payable "net cash," July 1st, 1902, without regard to date of purchase, or a cash discount of one per cent. per month on the unexpired time for credit, when paid before 1st July. Clovers, Timothy, Grasses, Seed Grains, Feeding Stuffs, Onion Sets, etc., noted "cash" or "market prices," are payable "Net Spot Cash," and subject to sight draft on shipment. Where there are no banks or express office, through which a draft can be made, prompt cash remittance is requested on receipt of invoice.

Any claims for allowance, errors or credits, must be made within ten days after arrival of goods or they will not be considered. Cash or satisfactory reference should accompany orders from unknown correspondents.

Orders in Hand

While we have endeavored to make prices as low as cost and quality will permit, our aim is to protect customers, who kindly entrust their orders with us, against lower prices which may be offered by reputable Canadian houses. Should lower prices be made you for like variety and quality on order with us, we ask that they be submitted, as we cannot consent to cancelling any order unless we are so advised and decline to meet such cut prices.

We carry no low grade or inferior "cheap" supplies, nor do we claim to compete against prices for such. Our constantly increasing trade is the strongest evidence that we supply "Best Quality" only. **Every merchant can increase his trade by considering "quality first" when procuring his supplies in seeds.**

We wish our many friends a prosperous season's trade and that we may share their success by the continuance of their valued confidence and orders.
