

# CABBAGE SEED A SPECIALTY.

TO THE TRADE:

We are now prepared for making contracts for growing the justly celebrated **LONG ISLAND CABBAGE SEED**, 1904 crop, of the best quality, and of all the popular sorts, at as low a price as first-class seed can be produced. We have for many years made the growing of CABBAGE SEED a specialty, and have introduced some of the choicest varieties known in the trade. Among them are All Seasons or Vandergaw, Mammoth Rock Red, Burpee's All Head and Solid South.

We cordially invite all interested to examine our stocks before putting in trenches in November, and compare them with others, the only way of knowing where the best sorts can be obtained. In evidence of the superiority of our stocks, we will say that a field of our coming NOVELTY was pronounced last November "THE BEST FIELD OF CABBAGE ON LONG ISLAND," and credited to another's stock of a different origin.

## Our Conditions of Contract are as Follows:

- 1st.—All Cabbage put out for seed is subject to inspection, either before being put away in the Autumn, or after transplanting in April, and if not perfectly satisfactory to our customers the contract may be annulled.
- 2d.—For seed purposes I put away only well developed heads, such as will plainly indicate the type.
- 3d.—Parties having a special type and furnishing their own stock seed will have it grown with the greatest possible care, and everything will be thrown out that is not true to type.
- 4th.—But one variety is grown by the same party, and not near enough to any other sort to endanger its purity from cross-fertilization.

TERMS:—Acceptance, with invoice, 6 months from December 1st. A discount of 5 per cent. allowed on all bills if paid within twenty days from date of invoice.

For seeds ordered after January 1st payments are due June 1st following.

We ask our customers to give explicit shipping directions, as our responsibility ceases when the goods are delivered to the express or freight offices and we take a receipt for the same.
