In presenting our Semi-Annual Trade List for the Fall of 1904, we wish to thank those whose patronage we have enjoyed in the past, and to assure them that we are better prepared than ever to handle their orders. To those who have never dealt with us, we will say that our soil enables us to produce nursery stock of the highest quality, clean, thrifty and well grown.

GRADES.

We grade carefully; in some cases by caliper, others by height; when by both, the caliper governs. In grading by height, the lower number is included, and the higher excluded; for example, the 4 foot trees are included in the 4 to 5 ft. grade, but the 5 foot trees go into the 5 to 6 ft. grade.

PACKING.

Prices do not include packing. We pack carefully in boxes; sometimes in bales, for which we make charge sufficient to cover cost of materials used; for large boxes, 8 or 9 feet, by $2\frac{1}{2}$ feet, \$3.00, and in proportion for larger or smaller boxes. A railroad switch runs to our packing house and car-load orders are packed directly into the car, without exposure of the trees.

TERMS.

Cash, or satisfactory security before shipment. Orders to be sent C. O. D. must be accompanied by at least one-fourth cash.

To prompt paying customers, whose responsibility is known to us, we will allow the usual 30 to 60 days credit from time of shipment.

GUARANTEE OF GENUINENESS.

While we exercise the greatest care to have all our trees and plants true to label and hold ourselves in readiness, on proper proof, to replace all trees that may prove untrue to label, free of charge, or refund the amount paid, it is mutually agreed between the purchaser and ourselves that our guarantee of genuineness shall in no case make us liable for any sum greater than originally received.

INSPECTION.

An Inspection Certificate will accompany each shipment, showing that our nurseries have been properly inspected; in addition to which we will have all shipments fumigated with hydro-cyanic acid gas, when requested so to do.
