## PLANTING 100,000 BULBS

### Gardeners Arranging Floral Treat for Philadelphia Next Spring.

City Forester Lewis began yesterday his preparations for a floral treat in the larger city squares next springtime.

A force of gardeners was set to work planting the 100,000 bulbs of tulips, hyacinths and narcissus.

The main displays will be in Independence and Logan Squares, but there will be beds in all the Philadelphia Public Parks.
