We are growing a fine lot of Seedlings as per enclosed list, especially American Persimmons, Red Bud, Sweet Gum, Black Locust, Sycamore and Japan Walnuts, of which we are growing an extra large lot and we are ready to book orders at prices enclosed. Would appreciate early orders, as stock may become exhausted before shipping season is over.

SEEDS

We will want Tree and Shrub Seeds, Cuttings, etc., for the coming season, and would appreciate a list of Seeds and Seedlings from any who can supply good, fresh stock early in season.

Would appreciate your early orders.

TERMS OF SALE

Evergreens will only be collected hereafter on damp days, and small lots should be expressed. Orders from strangers not financially rated should be accompanied by cash or good reference. Reasonable charges will be made for boxes or bales for trees, except when cash accompanies the order.

No charge for bags, boxes or barrels for seeds.

Seeds—5 pounds at ten pound rates; 25 pounds at 100 pound rates.

Seedlings—500 at 1000 rates; 5,000 at 10,000 rates.

Our responsibility ceases on delivery to transportation company and receipt taken. All orders to prepay stations should be accompanied by cash to cover freight. Add 8 cents for postage. Small orders from strangers should be accompanied by cash.

Send in orders early, especially for Tree Seeds.
