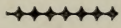

### TO THE TRADE

I have a large surplus of most of the following named stock on hand yet, especially of Tulip Poplar, Red Bud, Dogwood, Black Louest etc. My stock is very large and I will appreciate early orders. Packing will be done in heavy paper lined boxes with plenty of moss. Boxing done at cost. If cash accompanies order, packing free.

We have a good supply of the seeds named on enclosed list yet, but parties wanting seed should order at the earliest convenience. Any one wanting a special large lot of any variety, should write for special prices stating quantity wanted. Strangers not Commercially Rated, should send cash or give satisfactory reference.

We have a fine lot of very nice collected seedlings, fairly well graded, especially Dogwoods, Elms, Sweet Gum, Viburnum Acerifolium, Lindus, Rhus etc. Most all collected seedlings for putting out, should be cut back to crown before transplanting.

### TERMS OF SALE.

Evergreens will only be collected hereafter on damp days, and small lots should be expressed. Orders from strangers not financially rated should be accompanied by cash or good reference. Reasonable charges will be made for boxes or bales of trees, except when cash accompanies the order.

- No charge for bags, boxes or barrels for seeds.
- Seeds—5 pounds at 10 pound rates; 25 pounds at 100 pound rates.
- Seedlings—500 at 1,000 rates; 5,000 at 10,000 rates.

Our responsibility ceases on delivery to transportation company and receipt taken. All orders to prepay stations should be accompanied by cash to cover freight. Add 8 cents for postage. Small orders from strangers should be accompanied by cash.

Send in orders early, especially for Tree Seeds.
