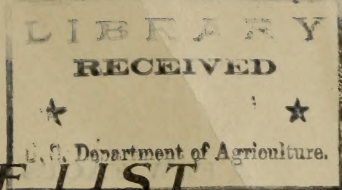



### To Whom It May Concern:

This is to Certify, That in accordance with an Act of the General assembly, approved April 20, 1901, I have on the 13th day of July, 1904, made an inspection of the Nurseries of the GLENN CLIFF NURSERY, at Winchester, Tennessee, and that I found the stock in these Nurseries apparently free from the San Jose Scale and all other insects and diseases of a seriously injurious nature.

This certificate is to cover only stock grown in the above named Nurseries, and becomes invalid after August 1, 1905.
