

When ordering trees to be shipped give address in full and state if by freight or express.

All goods travel at purchasers risk. Claims for delay or loss must be made to forwarders.

Notes About Pecan Trees

Distance of planting pecan trees should be 50 to 60 feet apart on light soil, and 70 feet or more on heavy soil.

Pecan trees should be planted a little deeper when they are set out than they stood in the nursery.

The dirt should be firmly settled about the roots of the tree so that the tree will take root.

With good care a pecan tree will grow faster each year.

Large seedling pecan trees may be top-grafted or budded.

When fertilizing pecan trees, do not put the fertilizer too near the roots of the tree.

All pecan trees offered for sale are root grafted.

They are Stuart, Pabst, Van Deman and a few of the Russell variety.

STUART



Is a well known nut and is one of the best.

PABST



Soft shell, well filled and good bearer.

VAN DEMAN



Is a Louisiana nut and is considered one of the best nuts of that State.

Stuart, Pabst and Van Deman nuts are all good and also well known nuts of good quality.

RUSSELL



True paper shell and is a good nut.
