CERTIFICATE NO. 42 TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

This is to Certify. That on July 23, 1938, the nursery grounds of The Tennessee Wholesale Nurseries, at Winchester, Tenn, were inspected by C. Pennington and myself; that the growing nursery stock was apparently free from San Jose Scale and other dagerously injurious insect pests and plant diseases.

Said nursery is equipped for fumigating all nursery stock.

This certificate has reference to insects and diseases, and is not otherwise to beconsidered as an endorsement of the parties to whom issued; it does not apply to stock not grown in the aforesaid nurseries unless such stock is covered by proper certificate in favor of the nursery where grown. It is not transferable and may be revoked for cause. This certificate becomes invalid after August 1, 1909, and cannot legally

be used after that date.

#### Location

A section of country noted throughout the United States as a great nursery center. Our soil is especially adapted to the growth of Nursery stock. There has never been any scale or any other insect diseases reported near us. We have a brick packing house, a brick fumigating house and are in connection with the Winchester Water Plant, which enables us to handle goods in the best possible manner.

#### Terms

Cash in advance unless otherwise arranged before stock is shipped.

#### Claims

All claims must be made immediately on receipt of goods, or ten days thereafter. Otherwise claims will not be allowed.

#### Guarantee

We exercise the greatest care to keep our varieties Pure and True to name, and we hold ourselves in readiness at all times to replace, on proper proof, all stock that may prove untrue. It is agreed by the purchaser that we, The Tennessee Wholesale Nurseries, J. C. Hale, Proprietor, shall not at any time be held liable for any amount greater than the purchase price.

#### Grading

We grade by height and caliper. The caliper always governing, unless specified by purchaser.

#### Packing

We begin packing Oct 1. and continue until about April 1. The packing is personally superintended by the proprietor, and we guarantee the delivery in first-class condition, where there is no unusual delay on account of the railroad. Usual charges for boxing and baling.
