

NORTH DAKOTA RESISTANT No. 73 FLAX: This variety was bred up by Prof. H. L. Bolley of the North Dakota Experiment Station for Wilt Resistance. In addition to its virtue of resisting wilt it has also proved to be a very heavy yielding variety on ordinary wilt-free soils. It is also somewhat less liable to rust than ordinary flax.
