Strawberry plants should always be forwarded by express.

Prices quoted do not cover risk of transplanting, which loss, if any, of right should be borne by the purchaser, who only can control the conditions after delivery; or any guarantee as to nomenclature. We agree, however, that to the best of our knowledge the varieties shall be true to label, and as evidence of good faith, we will replace, free of charge, any stock that proves untrue to label.
