

We are continually receiving inquiries asking us to furnish a list of the best Orchids for cut flower growing, and we have decided to continue the publication of such a list, as the previous one, No. 59, proved very successful. The list comprises all of the most showy kinds and the most useful for cut flowers besides such that are of easy culture. Anyone wishing to secure kinds not mentioned in this list we would ask them to write for our special list, No. 62, or our Catalogue of Orchids. CATILEYA BOWRINGIANA. Flowering season October-

ATTLEYA BOWRINGIANA. Flowering season October-November. A small flowering Cattleya with from 5 to 15 flowers on a stem of rose purple with darker lip. Very ornamental, and useful for cutting.

 CATTLEYA LABIATA. Flowering season October-November. One of the best known Cattleyas and most useful for cutting. Flowers large and showy. Bright rose with crimson purple lip.

CATTLEYA PERCIVALLIANA. (The Christmas Cattleya.) If you want to be absolutely sure to have Cattleya Flowers for Christmas you must have this species. C. labiata, as is well-known, is over by Christmas, and C. Trianae is then only commencing to come into flower, while C. Percivilliana is just then in full bloom. The stock offered is exceptionally fine.
