LOCATION.

Exeter is located 50 miles northeast of Boston on the Boston and Maine railroad in direct communication with Boston and New York.

This location is so far north that my stock is extremely hardy.

Our shipping season begins about the middle of April and lasts until June 1st and from September until the middle of November.

TERMS.

Terms net cash unless otherwise arranged.

Parties unknown to me must send cash or good reference.

Boxing and packing at cost.

While I am always ready to correct errors and mistakes which I make, if my attention is called to them upon receipt of goods, yet as I have no control over the planting and the weather conditions, I cannot assume any responsibility for the stock after being delivered to the transportation companies in good condition and taking their receipt thereof.

REMARKS.

I furnish trees and shrubs of any size suitable for transplanting, and a large number of shrubs and plants not quoted in this list.

I have an especially fine lot of Viburnums, Cornus Vacciniums and Ferns.
