

INTRODUCTORY

We undertook to issue a booklet, describing the marvelous display of seedling Gladioli, originating at our nursery, Mountain View, California, and which was awarded the Grand Prize at the Panama-Pacific International Exposition.

We find this cannot be done. Many rare varieties displayed, reproduce themselves slowly, and these bulbs, in quantity, can not be promised for several years.

It is not feasible from a commercial view, to continue the development of hundreds of seedlings even though showing extreme merit.

Gladioli experts and enthusiasts have repeatedly assured us that our strain, which we designate as "Metzner's Grand Prize Strain" is far in advance, in point of vigor, size and wonderful colorings, of the best varieties now generally offered for sale.

If you were not permitted to see our Exhibit at the Panama-Pacific International Exposition, picture if you can, GLADIOLI, standing, unsupported, from five to seven feet tall, many throwing three and four lateral shoots, producing flower spikes which could be cut over three feet in length, without touching the foliage.

Individual flowers, ranging from $4\frac{1}{2}$ to $6\frac{1}{2}$ inches in diameter, with 6 to 14 perfect flowers open at one time. An array of solid color tones or a blending of delicate tints, rivalling orchids in their richness. This is but a faint conception of the wonderful Gladioli display which won the admiration of thousands of flower lovers and brought us congratulations from Gladioli enthusiasts and specialists; a revelation to all as to the possibilities of this grand flower.
