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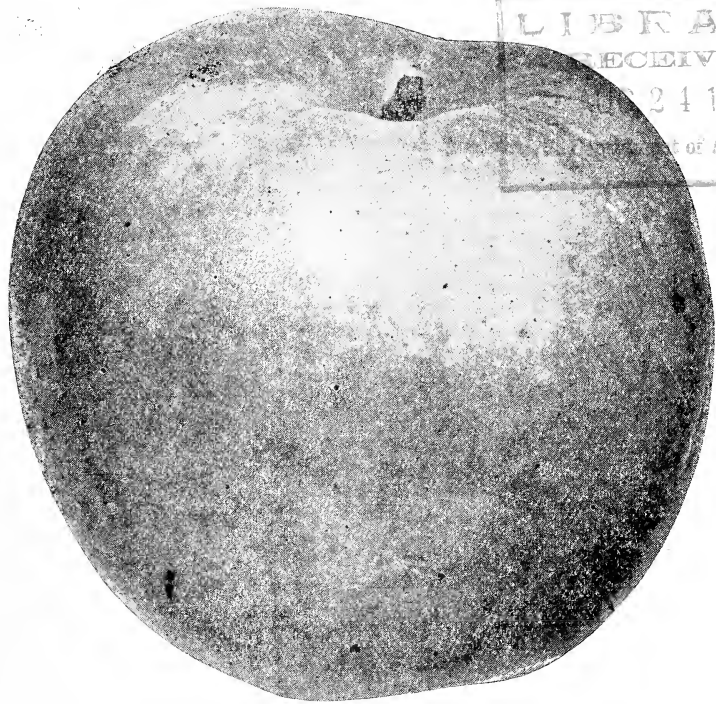

In no case do we assume responsibility after goods are shipped, unless for our own mistakes; if the purchaser does not accept goods on these terms, they are to be returned at once.

No claims for errors or shortage will be allowed unless made immediately upon receipt of same. We can not fill a long list for one or two of a kind at less than each rate, but we will supply 25 of a kind at hundred rate and 250 of a kind at thousand rate.

We guarantee the stock will be first class, true to name and in good condition when it leaves our grounds, and if any of our stock is not just as we represent it, all we ask of the purchaser is to return same.

TERMS—Cash with order from unknown parties, or satisfactory reference. If goods are to be sent C. O. D. one third of the amount must accompany the order. We make no charges for packing and boxing or delivery to rail road station.
