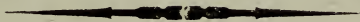

Explanation of Orchard Plan.

The standard trees are set 48 feet in the row with a plum between each apple, that makes them stand 24 feet. Then I set a peach between each plum and apple, that puts them 12 feet apart in the row and the rows are 20 feet apart. In the next row I set a plum opposite the apple, etc. On this plan you can get 154 trees to the acre. I put a row of raspberries or blackberries between each row of trees. Then I plant a row of strawberries, potatoes or tomatoes between the raspberry row and the trees, making the rows 5 feet apart, which gives plenty of room to cultivate your fruit. By having good ground and giving it the proper care your orchard will pay expenses each year.

In six or seven years the peaches should be cut out, and possibly in twenty years the plums should be taken out also, then your trees will stand 48x40 feet. with one in the center of the square, making it about 33 feet from the nearest tree.

In some of my orchards I use pears and in others I use early bearing apples such as Yellow Transparent, Duchess, Welthy, Falliwater, Wagner, etc.
