

Our nursery and farm is located between North Collins and Angola. We ship from both towns. At North Collins we have the Erie R. R. and at Angola the Lake Shore and Michigan Southern, the Nickle Plate and Pennsylvania Railroads. We have the Adams, American, National and Wells Fargo Express Companies which give good shipping facilities. We store Grapes, Currants, Goose-berries, Blackberries and Red Raspberries in the cellars for early Spring shipment. Strawberries and tip Raspberry plants are always fresh dug as wanted for shipping. Every box is carefully paper lined and no care will be spared to have the stock reach its destination in good condition.

No charge for packing packages or carting to depot, but after delivering to forwarding Company it is understood that we are released from any further responsibility for its safe arrival. We will, however, do everything in our power to trace and hurry shipment through. BEFORE SENDING US COMPLAINT OF DELAY BE SURE THE STOCK HAS PLENTY OF TIME TO REACH YOU.

GUARANTEE

We have every reason to think our stock pure and true to name, but we also realize that errors creep in, in unexpected places sometimes, and we sell with the understanding that we are not responsible for any damage over and above the first cost of the plants, should there be an error. All sales are made subject to above conditions.
